

Frequently Asked Questions

Does Monte Verde Inn have overnight accommodations? Monte Verde Inn allows guests to rent the Inn the night of the wedding. The inn can sleep up to 16 guests in our 3 shared rooms and 1 private room. Breakfast is included the next morning. We also do hotel room blocks with local hotels in the area.

Does Monte Verde Inn have site fees or facility fees? Monte Verde Inn does not have facility or site fees, we only ask that our couples reach the food and beverage minimum for their desired date. Food and beverage minimums can be found in our menu pricing packet.

Does Monte Verde Inn allow outside catering? Monte Verde Inn does not allow any Outside Catering for events within our venue, because we have our In-House Catering. Monte Verde Inn does allow one cultural appetizer and one cultural entrée to be brought in. Cultural appetizers and entrées must be prepared in advance.

Does Monte Verde Inn host rehearsal dinners? Monte Verde Inn only hosts your wedding rehearsal, not dinner.

How many weddings can Monte Verde Inn do each day? Since we are all inclusive we only do one wedding a day to insure the site is private just for you!

Why is buffet pricing more expensive than plated pricing? For buffet, we anticipate that your guests will try each dish that our Chef prepares, and go back for second options. The buffet stays open for an additional 10-15 minutes after the final guests make their selections.

What is the deposit for my desired date? We offer a 5 day courtesy hold for our couples once they come to tour Monte Verde Inn. Once those 5 days have passed we ask that you make a decision. If you decide to book we ask that you pay 25% of the total wedding. The Monte Verde Inn Sales Manager then creates a payment plan with you.

How late can weddings go at Monte Verde Inn? Monte Verde Inn has a noise ordinance of 10pm for outdoor weddings. We do allow weddings to go until 12am but they must move indoors where our maximum capacity is 100 guests.

Can wedding packages be longer than 5 or 6 hours? Monte Verde Inn charges \$500 per additional hour.

Does Monte Verde Inn do ceremony only? Monte Verde Inn offers ceremony and receptions together or reception only.

Does Monte Verde Inn provide alcohol or a bartender? Monte Verde Inn offers different bar options for our couples: hosted bar, per consumption or a cash bar. No matter what we provide a bartender!

What is the capacity? Monte Verde Inn can accommodate 220 guests outdoors (typically May-October) & 100 guests indoors (Typically late October-April)

Does Monte Verde Inn require event insurance? Monte Verde Inn requires that all of our couples retain a \$1 million general liability insurance policy naming Monte Verde Inn as additionally insured. We also require you vendors to have liability insurance. You can ask our coordinator for more information if needed.

Does Monte Verde Inn have getting ready suites? Yes we do!

What is the arrival time for the getting ready suites? Access to the getting ready suites begins at 12pm the day of the wedding.

Does Monte Verde Inn allow a “Send Off” after the wedding? We allow bubble, petal & glow stick exits. Have another idea for a Send Off? Ask the coordinator!

Does Monte Verde Inn allow confetti or seeds? We do not allow either on site.

Can I use real or fake petals for decor? We allow both!

Can I have candles on the table as décor? We allow candles as long as the flame is contained in either a votive, lantern or hurricane vase.

Does my coordinator assemble my DIY centerpieces & Decor? Your coordinator is responsible for the placement of all of your decor. Decor needs to arrived unwrapped, stickers/price tags off and assembled if necessary.

Can I take my food after the wedding is over? Due to health code violations food is not allowed to be boxed up after dinner.

Are animals allowed on Monte Verde Inn property? We love our furry friends but they are only allowed for ceremony & must be on a leash. After the ceremony they must leave the premises immediately. They are NOT allowed to stay in the rooms.
