



Posed Photography Picture List

My couples are welcome to choose which of the following portraits they would like to have taken on their wedding day. I will help to create the final posed picture list one month prior to the wedding during our final photography consultation.

Pre ceremony:

Taking the following posed portraits prior to the ceremony allows for a more relaxed portrait session following the ceremony. Pre ceremony portraits allow for time to mingle during cocktail hour, or more time for couple portraits.

Bride/mother	Groom/mother
Bride/stepfather	Groom/stepfather
Bride/father	Groom/father
Bride/stepmother	Groom/stepmother
Bride/parents	Groom/parents
Bride/parents/siblings	Groom/parents/siblings
Bride/siblings	Groom/siblings
Bride/each bridesmaid individually	Groom/each groomsman individually
Bride/bridesmaids	Groom/groomsmen
Bride alone (full length and close-up)	Groom alone (full length and close-up)
Bride/children	Groom/children

After ceremony during cocktail hour or after a First Look prior to ceremony:

Portraits typically take 5 minutes per set of parents, and 10 minutes per set of parents if extended family is included (aunts, uncles, cousins). Wedding party can take between 5-10 minutes depending on the size of the wedding party.

Couple with children

*The following is done with each set of parents:

Couple with children, parents, and siblings with spouses and children

Add grandparents (and extended family) on mother's side

Remove grandparents (and extended family) on mother's side and add grandparents (and extended family) on father's side

Couple with grandparents on father's side

Couple with grandparents on mother's side

Couple/wedding party

Bride/bridesmaids

Bride/groomsmen (upon request)

Groom/groomsmen

Groom/bridesmaids (upon request)

*Both classic and fun poses

Couple: Full length, close-up, classic, natural, casual, & fun (20 minute minimum recommended)
