

This is a quick update on the latest and greatest covid information for Long Term Care.

When Rules and protocols change for the general public as announced by the Provincial Health Officer, Dr. Bonnie Henry, those changes do not always apply to Long Term Care settings.

The following rules are still applicable to Long Term Care

- Only fully vaccinated visitors are allowed in the building
- Vaccine passports are still applicable and must be shown if it is your first visit to Buchanan. This information will be recorded for future reference.
- Masks are to be worn in all common areas
- Visitors 5 and older will be required to wear a mask in common areas
- Masks may be removed inside the resident's room
- Visitors may eat and drink inside the resident's room
- Rapid testing will continue for all visitors
- There are 4 visitors allowed in the resident's room
- Visitors are able to be in the lounge area with their loved one. We ask that you keep your distance from other residents when possible and keep your mask on.
