
## WALKING IN WISDOM




### WHAt Does it mean to Be wise?

Let's review what you read this week:

For the next 3 weeks, we will discuss a series called 'The Walk', and this week we are talking about walking in wisdom.

Jesus wants you to have wisdom. He's made it readily available, and all you have to do is ask. He wants you to be smart and make good decisions. Your good choices will cause you to stay free from sin and bring the blessing of God to your life. Not only do your decisions help your own life, they benefit others around you.

There are two kinds of wisdom, man's wisdom and God's wisdom. Men often think that wisdom is being smart, getting a good education, and having a successful life. God's wisdom is knowing God and what His Word tells us about how to live a life that Pleases Him.

By Pleasing God, you benefit in a major way! Did you see what Solomon received?! Having God's wisdom brings true peace and satisfaction.



Let's review what you read this week:

King David knew that his son Solomon would be Israel's next king. After King David died, his son Solomon became king over Israel, Solomon recognized that the Job to be king over God's people would require God's wisdom. Why do you think this request Pleased God? His focus was God-centered and not self-centered.

Solomon Asked God for wisdom, and he received it, plus honor and riches as well! The same wisdom that God gave Solomon is available to anyone who asks. Just like your memory verse for this week tells you, if we ask God for wisdom and look for his answers in the Bible, you can make wise decisions and help others see Jesus in our lives.
