CHRISTMAS WREATH COOKIES

This recipe can be used to make either little wreath cookies or one large wreath for a centerpiece at Christmastime.

Ingredients

- 1 stick butter
- 36 marshmallows
- 1 tsp vanilla extract
- 1 tsp green food coloring
- 7 C corn flakes

¼ C Red Hots, other cinnamon candies, or miniature red M&M's (for the berries on the wreath)

Directions

- 1. In a large saucepan, melt the butter.
- 2. Add marshmallows and stir constantly until all are dissolved.
- 3. Add the vanilla and the green food coloring and stir.
- 4. Add the corn flakes and stir with wooden spoon until blended.
- 5. Using a foil-covered pizza pan or large cookie sheet, spoon the mixture into one big circle, making it resemble a wreath. Immediately add the red candies to look like holly berries.

For small wreath cookies instead of one big wreath, spoon the mixture into smaller circles.

<u>Tip</u>: To avoid getting sticky fingers while shaping the wreaths, put a small amount of butter on your fingertips.
