WHO?

This trip is for Students who are 6th grade through 12th grade to attend as students. There are a few of our student leaders from College that will be attending as leaders along with several adult leaders as well.

WHAT?

Every year our students get the opportunity to attend Teen Valley Ranch for a week of summer camp. This camp is focused around relationship, building that students relationship with God, but also with other believers.

WHEN?

We will be traveling to TVR on Monday **July 12th** and returning on Monday **July 17th.** We will load onto the bus around **4:30 AM**. The bus will leave at **5:00 AM**. We will leave camp around **11:00 AM** only stopping for lunch and arriving back to the church no later than **6:00 PM**. Students who need rides home will contact parents when we are about two hours away from returning.

WHERE?

Teen Valley Ranch is located in Plumtree, North Carolina, roughly 45 minutes outside of Boone. (216 TVR Loop Rd, Plumtree NC 28664)

HOW?

Sunway Charters will be transporting the students and leaders to and from the Retreat Center. We are excited to have this opportunity to spend a long week in the mountains free from distractions to grow closer to God and together as a group.

COST?

The actual cost of this trip is around \$500 per student, however because of fundraising and donations that have been made to the Youth Ministry the only cost the students are responsible for is \$100 per student. This cost covers all of their food traveling up to camp, the camp itself along with food, and transportation and food for the return trip. The only additional money the students would need to bring would be if they would like to purchase anything from the Snack Shack (snacks, drinks, shirts, etc) and for Walt Bob's Coffee Shoppe.

EMERGENCY MEDICAL RELEASE AND CAMPER AGREEMENT
WE DO NOT REQUIRE NOTARIZED FORMS
 I/we hereby give permission for my/our child, who is a minor, to attend TVR Christian Camp and to fully participate in the activities offered for his or her age group. In the event of an emergency or sickness, I/we authorize TVR Christian Camp to secure medical treatment for my/our child, to be administered by authorized agents or agencies, as designated by TVR. I/we authorize TVR Christian Camp to administer those medications to my/our child which is indicated by a
 checkmark on the front side of this form according to the prescribed directions for each. If spaces are left blank, TVR WILL NOT dispense that particular medication unless a physician or parent/guardian is contacted for approval. 3. I/we agree to allow TVR Christian Camp to use any photographic image or video taken of named camper for promotional/marketing purposes. For safety there will be no names or information given about the individuals or groups in the photos.
4. I/we understand payment for medical bills for my/our child is my/our responsibility and the camper's family insurance plan is responsible for injuries and/or sickness at camp. TVR does NOT require that a guest be insured while at camp. We do offer an optional accidental insurance plan through Standard Life and Casualty Insurance Company, which may reduce some of the expenses in the event of an injury to your child (sickness is excluded). Coverage is explained on the separate application from Standard Life (your group leader should have a copy of this form). The cost is \$6.00 for children through 18 years old. IMPORTANT: Insurance application and a separate check made payable to TVR must be sent directly to TVR 30 days prior to attendance at TVR. Please send insurance application and check directly to P.O. I/we agree to waive and release TVR Christian Camp, its employees and volunteers from any claim or cause of actio that might arise on behalf of myself/ourselves or my/our child as a result of his or her participation in this event. Furthermore, I/we agree to assume all responsibility for my/our child's actions, including, but not limited to, the cost of repair or replacement for items damaged by willful abuse of my/our child and /or transportation costs, should it become necessary for my/our child to be sent home for medical or disciplinary reasons prior to the conclusion of this event.
 We (camper & family while on campus) agree to comply with all standing restrictions during our child's week of cam (information to be given prior to arrival). Parent/guardian acknowledges the assumption of risk of exposure to COVID-19 and other airborne viruses and agrees to not hold TVR liable for any related damage, loss, injury, or expense.

WHAT TO BRING TO TVR

What to Bring:

- Sleeping bag or sheets and pillow
- Towels and washcloths
- Toiletries
- Bible, pen, and notebook
- Jacket/sweatshirt
- Plenty of clothing that can get messy
- Long pants and tennis shoes for horseback riding
- Extra pair of shoes for water activities
- Western clothes for Rodeo night (summer camp only)
- Camera other than a cell phone (summer camp only)
- Snack Shack money

What NOT to Bring:

- Tobacco, alcohol
- Electronics
- Cell Phones (summer camp only)
- Bikinis or two-piece bathing suits
- Sleeveless shirts, shorts above midthigh (running/cheer shorts), or tight-fitting, revealing clothing, including leggings unless worn under an outer layer
- Weapons
- Pets
- Nuclear warheads

Your retreat is designed to leave a lot of these things behind for a little while in order to be a part of an atmosphere that is "free from all distractions." Cell phones service is very limited at camp. We have office phones available for use. TVR is not responsible for lost or stolen items.
