STEP 1: RESEARCH AND CHOOSE NURSING PROGRAMS:

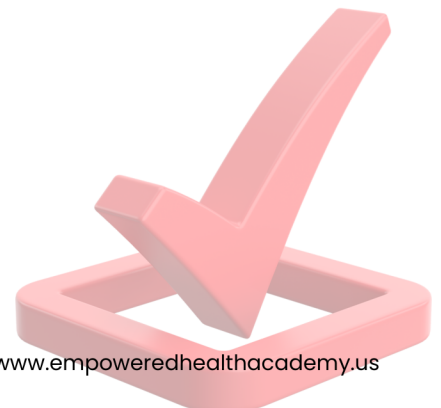
- Researchy accredited nursing programs.

STEP 2: REVIEW PREREQUISITES AND ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

STEP 8: FINANCIAL AID AND SCHOLARSHIPS:

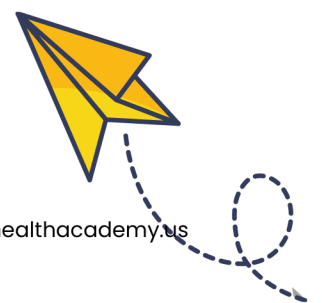
- Explore financial aid options and scholarships available for nursing students.
