Step 1:	Contact us at admin@drjuliaryan.ca or 613-699-0825 to discuss your request				
Step 2:	Complete a request form to be reviewed for suitability				
Step 3a:	Admin sends email with next steps, including: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Client to complete intake forms • Client to send supporting documents (report cards and past assessments) 				
Step 3b:	Intake meeting is scheduled in 4-6 months *Due to more limited availability, adults and children 5 years or younger may have longer waits				
Step 4:	Virtual or in-person intake meeting <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Clients under 10 years of age: parent(s), child can attend based on parent's judgment (If parents are separated and both are involved in care, both are invited to attend) • Clients 11-15: Client + parent(s) • Client 16yo+: Client and supporting person if desired Questionnaires are sent after the intake meeting to various raters				
Step 5:	In person testing			Virtual or In person interviews	In person testing + Interviews
2-4 weeks after intake	Two sessions of 2-2.5hrs Or One session of 4-5 hours (three shorter sessions may be suitable for some individuals)	Three sessions of 2-2.5hrs Or Two sessions of 3-3.5hrs Or Full day (recommended for older teens and adults)	One session of 1.5-2.5 hours or two sessions of one hour	Two or three 1hr sessions	Varies based on presenting issue
Step 6:	File is reviewed & report draft written				
Step 7: Step 4 to Step 7 usually takes ~8 weeks.	Virtual or in-person Feedback Meeting <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Clients under 10 years of age: parent(s), child can attend based on parent's judgment (If parents are separated and both are involved in care, both are invited to attend) • Clients 11-15: Client + parent(s) • Client 16yo+: Client and supporting person if desired Report is finalized and sent within 1-2 weeks after the meeting
