CONNECT

ENGAGE

What impacted you the most personally from the message?

GROW

1. The message highlights how noisy our world is. What are some of the biggest “noises” or distractions that keep you from hearing God?
2. The Jeremiah 6:16 passage (read it first) speaks about “ancient paths.” What does following the ancient path of faithfulness and obedience mean for us in 2025?
3. Read James 1:22. Why is it important to move from hearing to doing in our spiritual lives? 4. Who can you go to for spiritual wisdom or guidance about a decision you’re facing?
4. Read Matthew 11:28-30. How does Jesus define or describe the rest He offers?
