This week we are Talking About FRIENDSHIP

GOAL:

Understanding that as a Christian there are certain people we should and shouldn't have as friends. This doesn't mean we are unkind or unloving but there are certain friendships that you want to have.

WHAt DOES THE BIBLE SAY ABOUT Friendship?

The Bible tells us in 1 Corinthians 15:33, "Do not be misled: 'Bad company corrupts good character'." You want to have the right friends in your life. You don't want to have friends that get you to lie, sneak around, and say you don't have to do everything the Bible tells you. It's very important who we Hang with.

How CAn we be A Good friend?
