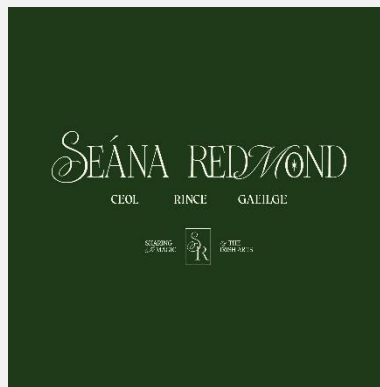

## TÉAMA NA SEACHTAINE – BIA & DEOCH

### This Weeks Theme – Food & Drink

#### Leibhéal 1 :

- **Bricfeasta (Breakfast):** gránach (cereal), bainne (milk), tósta (toast), sú oráiste (orange juice), cupán tae (cup of tea), leite (porridge), pancóg/pancóga (pancake/ pancakes), im (butter) caoineog (smoothie)
- **Lóin (Lunch):** arán (bread), ubh/ uibheacha (egg/ eggs), ceapairí (sandwiches), cáis (cheese), feol (meat/ham), ispíní (sausages), slisíní (rashers), torthaí (fruit)
- **Dinnéar (Dinner):** fataí/prátaí (potatoes), sicín (chicken), glasraí (vegetables), sceallóga (chips), iasc (fish)
- **Milseog (dessert):** milseáin (sweets), criospaí (crisps), uachtar reoite (ice cream), uachtar (cream), siúcra (sugar), cáca (cake), brioscaí (biscuits), seacláid te (hot chocolate)
- **Alcól (alcohol):** beoir (beer), lágar (lagar), leann dubh (stout), uisce beatha (whisky), fíon (wine), vodca (vodka), manglam (cocktail)
- **An maith leatsa tae? Is maith/Ní maith** – *Do you like tea? I like/ I don't like tea*

#### Leibhéal 2:

- **Is breá liomsa tae.** – *I love tea*
- **Tá grán (dearg) agam ar tae.** – *I (really) hate tea*

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**Leibhéal 2:****Réamhfhocail Shimplí (Simple Prepositions AKA Handy little words)****Grúpa 1:** (no change to the noun that follows)

- **ag (to have):** Tá leabhar ag Seán. – *Seán has a book.*
- **ag (at):** D’fhan an cailín ag geataí na scoile – *The little girl waited at the school gates.*
- **as (out of):** Is as Gaillimh mé. – *I am from Galway.*
- **le (with):** Chuaigh mé go Gaillimh le Máire. – *I went to Galway with Máire.*
- **chuig (to - sending):** Sheol mé litir chuig Sinéad. – *I sent a letter to Sinéad.*
- **go (to a place):** Thiomáin mé go Baile Átha Cliath. – *I drove to Dublin.*

**Grúpa 2:** (séimhiú, a ‘h’ is added to the noun that follows)

- **ar (on):** Tá cóta/áthas ar Sheán. – *Seán is wearing a coat / Seán is happy.*
- **roimh (before):** Chuaigh mé ag siopadóireacht roimh chóisir na Nollag. – *I went shopping before the Christmas party.*
- **faoi (under):** Tá an scéal sin faoi cheilt fós. – *That story is still a secret/ confidential.*
- **faoi (about):** Ar chuala tú faoi Sheán? – *Did you hear about Seán?*
- **thar (over):** Chuaigh an liathróid thar chlaí – *The ball went over a ditch.*
- **ó (from):** Fuair mé bronntanas álainn ó Shéamus. – *I got a lovely present from Seán.*
- **trí (through):** Thiomáin mé trí Bhaile Átha Cliath. – *I drove through Dublin.*
- **do (to - giving):** Thug sé barróg do Shinéad. – *He gave a hug to Sinéad.*
- **gan (without):** Ná gabh amach gan chóta ort! – *Don’t go out without a coat!*
- **mar (as):** Bhí an cailín beag gléasta mar chailleach d’oíche Shamhna. – *The little girl was dressed as a witch for Halloween.*
- **idir (between):** Tá mé idir dhá intinn. – *I am between two minds/undecided.*
- **sa (in):** Tá milseáin sa chófra. – *There are sweets in the press.*

**Grúpa 3:** (urú is added to the noun that follows)

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**i (in a place):** Tá siopaí deasa i nGaillimh. – *There are lovey shops in Galway.*

## GAEILGE SA MBAILE

### Irish in the home

1. **An bhfuil ocras ort? Tá/ Níl.** – *Are you hungry? Yes/ No*
  - **Tá mé stiúgtha leis an ocras.** – *I am starving!*
  - **Cineáláin – beidh rud beag agam.** – *Kind of, I will have something small.*
2. **An raibh codladh maith agat aréir? Bhí/ Ní raibh** - *Did you have a good sleep last night? I did/ I didn't*
3. **A stór, a stórin, a leanbh, a chroí, mo chroí, a thaiscí** - *(names of affection)*
