



Since 2012, The Net has served over 1,600 survivors of sex trafficking as they have rebuilt their lives and walked forward in freedom.

THE PROBLEM

Survivors of sex trafficking face significant barriers to rebuilding their lives and the buyers who perpetuate the problem are not held accountable.



According to the FBI, less than 1% of trafficking victims are kidnapped. Rather, they are exploited by someone they know and trust.



85-95% of those experiencing exploitation want to escape but have no other options for survival.



PURCHASED PROGRAM

Our Purchased Program provides a trauma-informed community of support for survivors of trafficking.

Through our three-pronged approach including Outreach, Advocacy, and Enrichment, women are empowered to rebuild their lives and walk in freedom!

To date, we have completed over 2,000 visits to survivors in jail and distributed over \$55,000 in financial incentives through Enrichment since its inception in 2022.



OUTREACH

Through weekly jail outreach and survivor-lead support groups, we share with survivors that they are seen, known, and loved and invite them to take the next step in rebuilding their lives.



ADVOCACY

Through Advocacy, The Net creates a network of support for survivors of trafficking through one-on-one relationships with trained volunteers and monthly recreational events.



ENRICHMENT

Through Enrichment, survivors of trafficking can earn financial incentives as they participate in case management, goal setting, and life skills classes such as Banking 101, GED Prep, and Workplace Readiness.

MASE PROGRAM

MASE (Men Against Sexual Exploitation) disrupts sex trafficking at the source and reduces demand through buyer engagement and community education.

Research shows that 2 out of 3 men who purchase sex say they want to stop. Led by men, MASE works to disrupt sex buyers and affect broad culture change to protect vulnerable women and children.

To date, we have disrupted over 8,000 individual men attempting to purchase sex and trained teams in 4 states on anti-demand initiatives.



THE WORTHY CO. PROGRAM

The Worthy Co. supports survivors of trafficking through dignified employment and hands-on job training.

Survivor artisans at The Worthy Co. handcraft candles and jewelry, which are for sale in our online and brick and mortar retail stores.

As a non-profit social enterprise of The Net, 100% of every purchase empowers women as they rebuild their lives!

To date, we have provided over 13,000 hours of dignified employment for 20 survivors of trafficking.
