



## UPDATES FROM BLAKE ARMSTRONG Buchanan Lodge E.D.

## **Dear Family and Friends,**

As reported in the media, there are now easings of long-term care COVID-19 restrictions. The Ministry of Health, in consultation with the Public Health Officer and health authorities, has advised of the following practice changes:

- 19 symptoms prior to each visit.
- ♦ The maximum limit of 2-adults plus 1-child visitors is no longer in effect.
- Buchanan-wide indoor social and recreational events and gatherings involving residents and staff from multiple houses/floors will be reinstated.
