COME AND SEE

1. Jesus invites (YOUR NAME) to come and see.

2. I'm invited to REMAIN in Him.

3. Jesus is inviting me into a PERSONAL EXPERIENCE.

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DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

February 15, 2026

CONNECT

Have you ever been so excited to show someone something that you could hardly contain yourself? What was it that you wanted them to see or experience?

ENGAGE

What impacted you the most personally from the message?

GROW

1. If Jesus asked you “What do you want? What would your honest answer be? What are you truly seeking in your faith right now?
2. John remembered the exact time—about 4pm—when he first spent extended time with Jesus because it changed his life. Can you recall a specific moment or season when spending time with God significantly impacted you? What made that time memorable?
3. Jesus invites us to “remain” in Him. What’s the difference between remaining with Jesus and just checking in periodically? What makes remaining difficult in our current culture?
4. What questions or doubts have you wrestled with in your faith journey? How has Jesus met you in those doubts?

LEAD (YOURSELF):

This week, when you feel overwhelmed, stop and ask yourself these three questions:

1) What am I carrying right now? (Pressure / fear / guilt / control / people-pleasing / anxiety / responsibility / disappointment)

2) Did Jesus ask me to carry this?

3) What would it look like to come to Jesus in this moment? Not later. Not when the day is over. Right now. Maybe it looks like a simple breath prayer: Inhale... then exhale.

“Jesus, I’m coming to You.”

“Jesus, give me rest.”

“Jesus, help me release this.”

“Jesus, I take Your yoke.”
