# WEEK 4 DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

## [CONNECT]

What's the best thing you've ever discovered in an out of the way place? Restaurant? View? Friendship?, etc.

## [ENGAGE]

What impacted you the most personally from the message?

## [GROW]

Take turns around your group reading through John 11:1-44. What stands out in this story about Lazarus? Why do you think Jesus waited? v. 35 is the shortest verse in the Bible "Jesus wept." Why do you think he wept?

Are there hopes and dreams that have died in you? How can you bring those to Jesus to find life?

Look up these verses in your group and read them out loud. Matt. 14:23; Matt. 26:36; Mark 1:35; Mark 6:46; Luke 5:16; Luke 6:12; Luke 9:18; Luke 11:1. Why do you think Jesus did this again and again?

How can you live in a different rhythm to have time to connect with Jesus?

Read Matt 9:9-13. How do you think Matthew felt when Jesus invited him? What was it about Jesus that "disreputable sinners" found engaging? How have you experienced wholeness in Jesus?

## [LEAD (YOURSELF)]

Commit to taking several days this week and making time to connect with Jesus. You don't need to "accomplish" anything... just be WITH Him. It will probably be uncomfortable at first, but stay quiet and sense His presence with you.
