



INTRODUCTION

Your engagement session is a great opportunity to spend some time with your fiancé getting comfortable in front of my camera! I love engagement sessions that are romantic, fun, or just all about the two of you. The best way to approach your session is to treat it like a date-night. Typically lighting is best during the last few hours of sunset, so our time will vary based on the season.

WHEN TO SCHEDULE

I suggest getting your session scheduled soon after you book! This will help ensure that you get your first choice of season, date, etc. Spring and fall are really popular for engagement sessions, as the weather is usually ideal.

CHOOSING A LOCATION

Think about the activities that you like to do together and get creative! Maybe you have access to something cool, like an airplane, a rooftop deck with skyline views, or a private estate on the lake. Anything that can set your session apart is great! Consider the outfits you want to wear and a location that compliments your vision. Choosing a location that has a good mix of nature and architecture will add some interesting elements and variety.

WHAT IF THE WEATHER IS BAD?

As your engagement session date approaches, we will keep track of the forecast. Since the weather can change quickly and be hard to predict, I recommend waiting as close to the day as you can, before we make any plans to reschedule.







HAIR & MAKEUP

This is a great opportunity to have your hair and makeup trial done with your wedding professional. Not only does it make a big difference in the photo quality, but you'll be able to experiment with how your make up looks in front of the camera for your day. A quick blow-out would add an extra "wow" factor to your photos!;)



WHY TAKE ENGAGEMENT PHOTOS?

My goal is to have you feel as comfortable as possible on your wedding day. The best way to do that is to actually experience what it will feel like to be in front of the camera in first hand! This is the perfect opportunity for me to get to know the two of you before the wedding day (and vice-versa!). That way, there's no awkwardness or worrying about your photos being perfect on the wedding day. Just stress-free fun with your family & friends!

PREPARING YOUR YOUR GUY FOR PHOTOS

I get it, spending time in front of the camera doesn't sound appealing to most men. I completely understand this, and try to make the process as painless as possible for both of you. First off, I'll start by saying that if you like spending time with each other, you're already off to a great start! Haha! The session is more about getting the two of you to interact, rather than having you pay attention to me. Not to worry, I will give you plenty of guidance and prompts on what to do and how to have fun. Include your fiancé in making your engagement plans and choose something that sounds fun to both of you.
