DO YOU ALWAYS WISH THERE WERE BETTER POCKETS IN YOUR JEANS?

FIRST, <u>GIRL JEANS</u> WITH TOO SHORT FRONT POCKETS, AGH!

THE ONE PLACE I WISH THERE WERE DECENT POCKETS ARE IN MY JEANS SO MY PHONE AND ANYTHING ELSE WON'T FALL OUT.

IS IT ONLY ME OR WOULD YOU LIKE YOUR HANDS TO FIT INSIDE A LITTLE BETTER TOO?

- A THE FIRST STEP IS TO TURN THE JEANS INSIDE OUT. CUT THE SHORT POCKETS AT THE BOTTOM SEAM TO MAKE AN OPENING.
- B FIND ANY LIGHTWEIGHT FABRIC FROM A BLOUSE, T-SHIRT (SEE BELOW) OR THIN SOCK AND SEW THE TOE TO THE OPENING.
- WHATEVER FABRIC YOU USE, CUT
 ABOUT A 9"LENGTH BY 7" WIDTH FOLD
 IT IN HALF SEW THE SIDES AND THEN
 SEW THE "NEW LENGTH" TO THE JEAN
 POCKET OPENING WITH A SEAM AND
 YOUR DONE -NORMAL FUNCTIONAL
 POCKETS -ALAS!.

SECOND, ADD INSIDE POCKETS!

RIP OR CUT A POCKET OFF AN OLD PAIR OF JEANS AND SEW IT TO THE INSIDE BREAST OF YOUR FAVORITE JACKET WITH A SLIP STITCH.








Shortcuts for making pockets!


REALIZE YOU CAN CUT UP OTHER CLOTHES:

Cut a pair of pants down from the waist in a shape to add to a skirt, or sweatshirt without pockets? Hand or machine











Add pockets all over.



Go through your closet to find clothes you no longer wear to use for pockets or to add pockets to.



Examples of patch pockets



Add a flap across a breast pocket for style interest and to hold the contents inside.

SOME TIPS FOR ADDING POCKETS TO ALMOST ANYTHING IS TO ALWAYS LEAVE PLENTY OF SEAM ALLOWANCE, **ABOUT AN INCH**. THESE THINGS TEND TO SHRINK AND THAT WAY YOUR POCKETS WILL ALWAYS

BE BIG ENOUGH

THE MOST FUN OF ALL IS MAKING PATCH POCKETS!

- RECTANGLE POCKET
 - ADD A PATCH POCKET BY CUTTING A RECTANGLE SEVEN OR EIGHT INCHES WIDE AND NINE INCHES LONG, GIVE THE TOP A BIG FOLD DOWN
 - STITCH ANYWHERE ON A DRESS, TOP, OR SKIRT.
- AMORPHOUS POCKET-MAKE ANY SHAPE
 - LAY A POCKET FABRIC DOWN WHERE YOU WANT A
 POCKET AND STITCH A SHAPE ON TOP LEAVING
 AN OPEN SPACE FOR A FOLD DOWN OR OPENING
 FOR YOUR HAND
 - CUT 1/2"AWAY FROM THE STITCH LINE
- CIRCLES, FUNNELS, TRIANGLES, ANY SHAPE YOU WANT? I HAVE SEEN FUNNEL POCKETS.









SIDE POCKET OR INSEAM POCKETS

- OPEN THE SIDE SEAMS WHERE YOU WANT THE POCKETS ABOUT 8"-THE FINISHED OPENING IS 6"
- CUT FOUR PIECES (HAND SIZE) OR USE THE PATTERN ON THE LAST PAGE
- SEW THE PIECES ON THE SEAM BEFORE YOU SEW THE POCKET BAG TOGETHER, IT'S EASIER.



3 FUN EASY STEPS TO MAKE YOUR POCKETS:




CUT OUT THE FABRIC
