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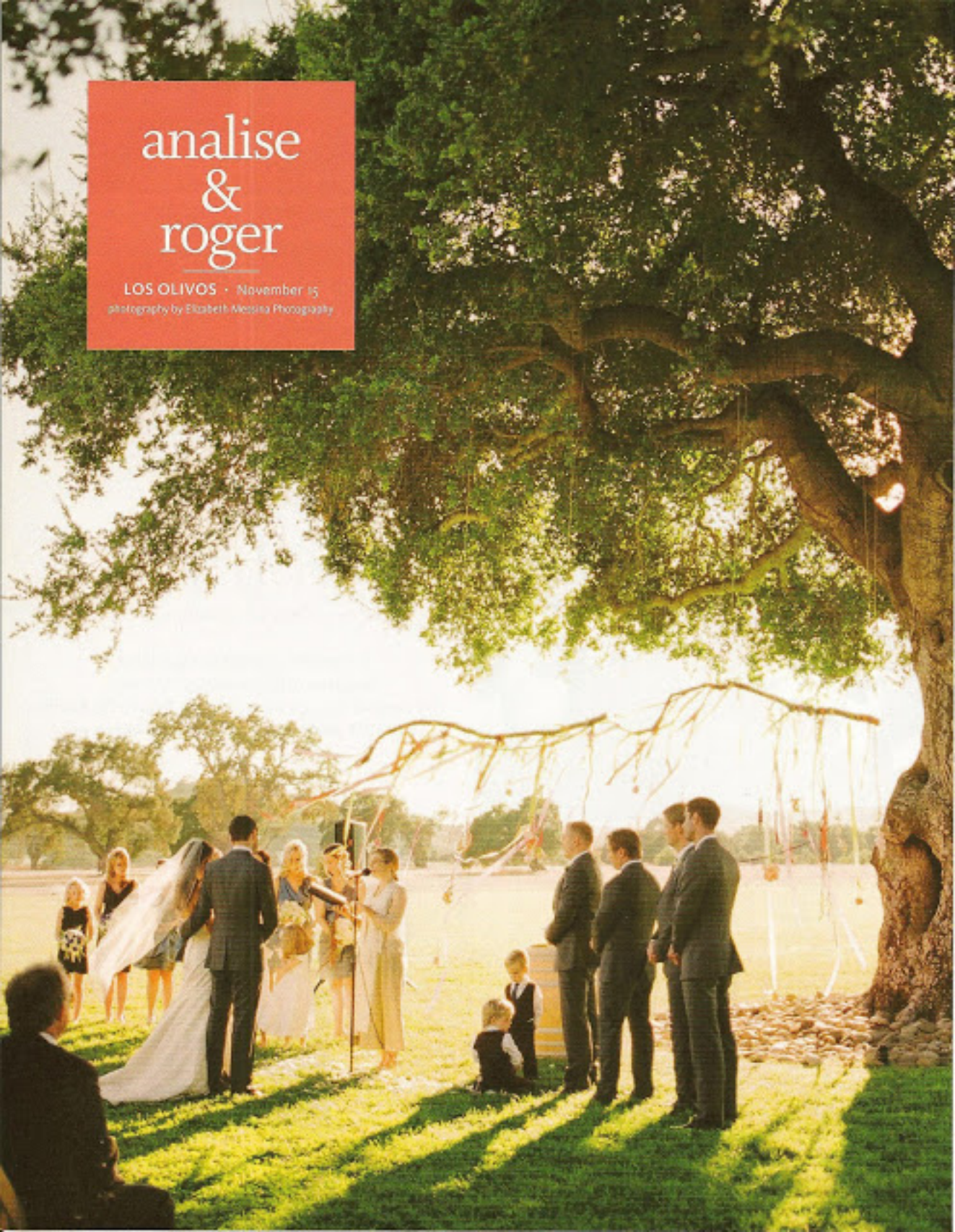

The couple exchanged vows beneath an old oak tree. Colorful silk streamers and flowers hung from its branches and blew in the wind behind them.

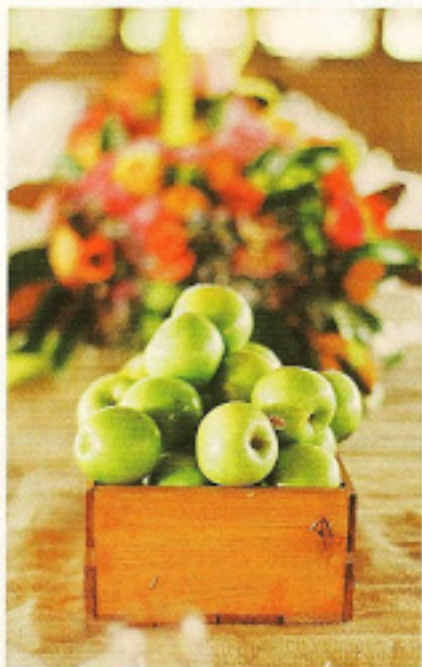
**the escort cards**

**the centerpieces**

**style notes**

A child running barefoot in the grass with fireflies at dusk was what inspired the atmosphere at Analise and Roger's wedding. The couple translated that vision into a relaxed but elegant style with vintage details and an earthy but vibrant color palette.

At sunset, the party moved into the barn for dinner and dancing. Ribbon streamers hang from a long branch over the head table.
