Each year, dollars raised through the Read-A-Thon fuel the extras that make school feel special: teacher and staff appreciation, student field trips, arts programming, campus performances, and memorable school-wide events. We also take on one major project annually to keep BHP growing, thriving, and forward focused. This year, we are dreaming big!
