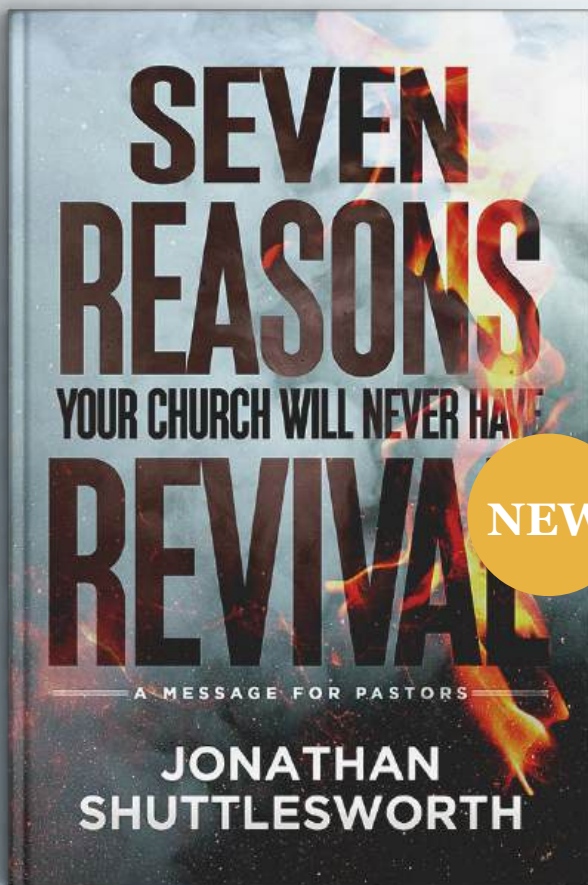

Revival Today Church Fort Worth

Revival Today Church kicked off 40 Days of Faith for America with A Healing and Revival Crusade with Dr. Pastor Paul Enenche. On the first anniversary of Revival Today Fort Worth, the event broke the attendance record when over 1200 people packed in to hear the Word. The record only held for twenty-four hours, as almost 1400 people poured in for night two and stayed past 11:30 p.m., worshiping in God's presence and testifying of God's miraculous healing power. The visual and hearing impaired were healed and the lame walked!

On night one, Pastor Jonathan set the stage for Pastor Paul with a compelling call to action for all believers.

These miraculous signs will accompany all who believe: They will cast out demons in my name, and they will speak in new languages. They will be able to handle snakes with safety, and if they drink anything poisonous, it won't hurt them. They will be able to place their hands on the sick, and they will be healed. (Mark 16:17-18)

The days of signs and wonders following believers are coming back to America now! Every religion can take you to the tomb of their founder. Only Christianity can bring you to an empty tomb because Jesus is not dead – He's alive forevermore! This fact can be proven in several ways, but Jesus' favorite way to confirm His Word is through the transformation of the Z of those who hear His Word.

As Pastor Jonathan turned the service over to Dr. Paul, the pastor of Dunamis, a 100,000-seat church, the largest on planet Earth, and in the 2000-year history of The Church, he urged everyone to turn their faith loose to receive from God.

On night one, Pastor Paul addressed the origins of man.

- 1. The origin of a thing is its place of destiny.** If you want to be successful, you must return to your place of origin. When God created man, He spoke to Himself. (Genesis 1:27)
- 2. It's impossible for man to exist without God.** God created man for His pleasure. (Revelation 4:11)
- 3. Man was created in the climate of God's breath, glory, and presence.** When we get away from God's climate, we experience withdrawal symptoms. We were never meant to function outside of His climate. (Genesis 2:7)
- 4. Man was created in the image and likeness of God.** If you want to be a successful child of God, you must remain in God's company. (Proverbs 13:10)

On night two, Pastor Paul revealed what causes people to lose individual revival and how to restore it.

- 1. Giving an ear to the voice of the god of this world causes you to lose connection to the voice of God.** In Genesis, Eve agreed to engage with the Devil. We live in a world of voices (1 Cor. 14:10). Most voices are contrary to the plan and truth of God's Word. Refuse to give your ear to any voice that is contrary to the Word of God; reject the speech and the speaker.
- 2. Insufficient knowledge of God and His Word.** The serpent approached Eve because she lacked knowledge of God's Word. When God gave Adam instructions about The Garden, Eve had not been created yet. It appears Adam did not properly instruct Eve on what God said. That's why the serpent asked Eve, "Did God really say?..." The serpent was able to deceive Eve by convincing her that eating the fruit would make her like God. She was not aware that she was already like God, created in His image and likeness.

Keys to Restore Individual Revival

1. **Deep, genuine repentance.** Repent for any attempt to exist independent of God and behaving as though you own your life. (Isaiah 57:17)
2. **Decide to serve God on His terms.** Allow your will to be swallowed up in the will of God. (Luke 22:42) Those who end up in Hell will be those who lived for themselves.
3. **Possess the passion to settle for nothing less than the best of God.** God's best is what no eye has seen. (1 Cor. 2:9) I made up my mind years ago that I wanted to reach the highest place possible for a man to walk with God in the flesh. Don't settle for a shadow of God, press in and make His best a reality in your life.
4. **The Act of Persistent Prayer.** Pray like you breathe. The Bible says to pray without ceasing (1 Thes. 5:17). My definition of prayer can be described in this way: A person who survives by driving for a living is called a driver; someone who teaches for a living is called a teacher. A person who survives by praying is called a *pray-er*. A *prayer* is someone who doesn't just pray, they *are* prayers. They possess an infectious spirit of prayer that makes others want to pray when they are around them.

We are in the final hour. The Devil knows his only chance to take down America is to destroy The Church. This Healing and Revival Crusade was a major detriment to the plans of Hell. We'll continue to punch the Devil in the face with the Word of God throughout the remainder of these forty days and until Jesus returns!



TESTIMONY!

In February 2021, my wife suffered a major attack on her body that put her in the ICU. She woke up in the hospital without any feeling in her limbs. She couldn't lift her head or speak.

I wasn't allowed to stay with my wife due to Covid protocols. I received a call from the hospital alerting me that my wife died, but was resuscitated. Immediately, I fell on my knees and cried out to God, "Lord, you brought her to me, I give her back to you."

The doctors operated on a cancerous cyst in my wife's stomach that had spread to her brain. I had one opportunity to visit her before the surgery. I brought anointing oil and covered her from head to toe. Then all hell broke loose. She stopped breathing, and her liver and kidneys began to shut down. Blood stopped flowing through her body and the doctors said they would need to amputate her arms and feet. They took an X-ray and found holes in her lungs. I countered with the Word, "No, you foul-eyed devil, you ain't cutting nothing off. We are one. I'm healed, so she's healed."

I grabbed Pastor Kofi's book on prayer, *Boldy I Come*, and spoke all the prayer points over my wife. That's when everything in her body began to function properly. Her kidney began to work; then her liver started working. They took two X-rays in preparation for operating on her deflated lungs. During the second x-ray, the doctors watched as her lungs inflated before their eyes. All I could say was, "That's my God!"

The Doctors never had to cut my wife open. She received a new liver, kidney, and lungs and her cancer is completely gone. God completely restored her. I want to thank Pastors Rodney and Jonathan because what they preach instilled faith in us to weather the storm and caused the Word of God to come out of me.

Last year's Breakthrough in Ministry (BIM) conference kicked off with Pastor Jonathan ministering on the overlooked and misunderstood topic of ministry finances. Here are 13 keys to operating in supernatural finances.

1. Walk in God's Covenant

Then Peter opened his mouth and said: "In truth I perceive that God shows no partiality. But in every nation whoever fears Him and works righteousness is accepted by Him." Acts 10:34 - 35 (NKJV)

God has no respect for skin color or educational background. What He does for one, He'll do for anyone. The steps He outlines in His Word may be repeated by anyone. What He cares about is obedience, your motivations for obedience, and the degree you obey Him.

The nation you live in has no bearing on your prosperity. The richest ministries in the world are in West Africa, with an 800-to-1 exchange rate to our dollar. Yet, many American ministries have

less than \$200 in the bank despite the abundance all around them.

2. Apply Kingdom Financial Laws

The Bible contains laws that govern the financial anointing, just like it contains laws that govern the healing anointing. If you understand how the financial anointing functions, there's no guesswork, hoping, or calling people on the phone to pray against a demon of poverty. There's just the application of Kingdom laws and the manifestation of your financial Covenant with God.

3. Expand in the Financial Anointing

You are not a serious minister if you're not concerned about finances, because money is a tool that enables you to help more people. The less money you have, the less people you can help. If finances aren't important to you, growth is not important to you. If you are believing God for breakthrough and growth in your ministry, it's going to require more employees, office space, parking, and all the things that accompany growth. Thankfully, the same God who expands your ministry makes increase effortlessly available to you.

The blessing of the LORD makes a person rich, and He adds no sorrow with it. Proverbs 10:22 (NLT)

The blessing of the Lord doesn't simply meet the need; it makes a man rich! The impartation you will receive is not just for increase, but an effortless, enjoyable increase.

4. Partner to Build His Kingdom

Now may He who supplies seed to the sower, and bread for food,

supply and multiply the seed you have sown and increase the fruits of your righteousness. 2 Corinthians 9:10 (NKJV)

The fastest you'll ever see money come into your hands is when you make a covenant vow with God to do something to build His Kingdom. If God can get it into your heart, He'll get it into your hand. Many people don't walk in Kingdom prosperity because nothing about the Kingdom moves them. It's all about *their* ministry and what *they're* doing. They don't have a clue about what God is doing or what He wants done in His Kingdom. A Kingdom mindset is not, 'Who will bless me?' but, 'Who can I bless?'

5. Sow Generously, Reap Abundantly

But this I say, He which soweth sparingly shall reap also sparingly; and he which soweth bountifully shall reap also bountifully. 2 Corinthians 9:6 (KJV)

Ministries that struggle financially don't sow significant seeds.

It's impossible to sow generously and not reap generously. The Devil is not responsible for your lack of prosperity. He can't alter God's Word.

The principles I've highlighted fly in the face of the common sense, budgeting, and stewardship principles you've heard elsewhere. I decided that any time my cultural upbringing conflicts with what I read in the Bible, I'm going with what Jesus said. Until you break out of your cultural upbringing, you can't enter into Kingdom prosperity.

6. Trust in God Alone

When Abram was ninety-nine years old, the LORD appeared to Abram and said to him, "I am Almighty God [El-Shaddai]; walk before Me and be blameless. And I will make My covenant between Me and you, and will multiply you exceedingly."
Genesis 17:1 – 2 (NKJV)

It irritates God when you look to man instead of Him. You can't look to both at the same time. Partners didn't call me into the ministry; God called me into the ministry. God is my Supplier. I thank our partners but never cross the line of giving them credit for our success.

You're not limited by your partners; you are only limited by your God, who is unlimited. The One Who owns all the silver and gold is your ministry and business partner. When you put God first in all you do, God will place His touch on the works of your hands, and you will experience overflow in all you do.

7. Develop the Muscle of Giving

Since you excel in so many ways—in your faith, your gifted speakers, your knowledge, your enthusiasm, and your love from us—I want you to excel also in this gracious act of giving.
2 Corinthians 8:7 (NLT)

If you're going to operate God's way, you must understand that finances don't come from human effort but by divine *giving grace*. Offerings are not about *taking money from you* but *getting money to you*. The grace for giving puts everyone else first. It's not just about caring for the *work* of the Lord but caring for the *workers* conducting the work of the Lord. Your giving refreshes and impacts them. Stop focusing on who will bless you and start focusing on who to bless and you'll never lack resources again.

The giving grace is like a muscle you develop. That's why giving is so important. It becomes something you enter into with delight. You become glad to give and you do it with a merry heart. You become like God who gave continuously. Let that grace come upon you today and may your life never be the same.

8. Set Your Affection on God's Kingdom

"And now, because of my devotion [KJV: affection] to the Temple of my God, I am giving all of my own private treasures of gold and silver to help in the construction. This is in addition to the building materials I have already collected for His holy Temple."
1 Chronicles 29:3 (NLT)

When you set your affection on something, you find a way to get it. *Where your treasure is, there your heart will be also* (Matt. 6:21). Low, pathetic giving indicates that His Kingdom is not your primary concern. You don't have affection for it. Fall in love with God and His work. David *gave all* to the temple and he did it while he was *alive* to see it get used.

9. Give to Move God's Heart

They even did more than we had hoped, for their first action was to give themselves to the Lord and to us, just as God wanted them to do.
2 Corinthians 8:5 (NLT)

The giving grace starts when God's Kingdom becomes what you eat, sleep, and breathe. You get involved in the work of the Lord and find good ground for your seed. Giving sets you apart. People might not know who gave, but God knows. The Bible says Jesus stood at the front of the temple and looked at what everyone put into the treasury (Mark 12:41 – 44). Of everyone who gave, only one person gave something that moved the heart of God. This woman gave everything she had.

10. Be Redeemed from Poverty

You know the generous grace of our Lord Jesus Christ. Though he was rich, yet for your sakes he became poor, so that by his poverty he could make you rich. 2 Corinthians 8:9 (NLT)

Jesus didn't die to meet your needs. The redemptive blood of Jesus broke poverty just like it broke sickness. Many denominations make the blood of Jesus of little effect. They don't believe it frees you from sin, sickness, disease, or the curse of poverty. But the blood has the same efficacy today as it's always had. It broke the power of sin! It broke the power of every sickness and disease! And by His poverty, He has made us rich! Receive that grace.

11. Be Directed by the Spirit

Remember this—a farmer who plants only a few seeds will get a small crop. But the one who plants generously

will get a generous crop. You must each decide in your heart how much to give. And don't give reluctantly or in response to pressure. "For God loves a person who gives cheerfully."
2 Corinthians 9:6 – 7 (NLT)

The Bible says not to give to the dead (Deut 26:14). Don't sow into dead, rocky, stony soil. The same way you must purpose in your heart to hear from God regarding *what* to give, you must hear *where* to give. If Abraham had sacrificed his son Isaac on any other mountain, he would have killed his son for free. God didn't just tell him *what* to give, He told him *where* to give. When you give as directed by the Spirit, you may leave with nothing, but you'll feel the best you've ever felt. Happy as a lark! It just has to be done in faith.

12. Hear How God Speaks Through Money

Pay attention if your money dries up where you've sown it. Ask yourself, 'Is God in this? Or is it just a good idea?'

Lester Sumrall had a rule that every facet of his ministry had to *at minimum* break even. So, if the coffee shop lost money, he shut it down. No part of his ministry would pay for another part of the ministry. If it's not producing money, God's not in it.

13. Always Give God Your Best

"But you ask, 'How have we ever shown contempt for your name?' "You have shown contempt by offering defiled sacrifices on my altar. "Then you ask, 'How have we defiled the sacrifices?' "You defile them by saying the altar of the LORD deserves no respect. When you give blind animals as sacrifices, isn't that wrong? And isn't it wrong to offer animals that are crippled and diseased? Try giving gifts like that to your governor and see how pleased he is!" says the LORD of Heaven's Armies.
Malachi 1:7 – 8 (NLT)

You cannot give God worthless sacrifices. You cannot give Him your trash and expect His treasure. I made a vow early in my life that has produced everything of worth in my ministry. I told the Lord, "The largest check I ever write will *first* be to Your Kingdom—not my ministry." So, the first \$1000 I ever spent was when I gave \$1000 in the offering.

Instead of putting yourself first, start putting God first. Then all the other things you seek after, God will add them to you. He'll choose better for you than you would choose for yourself. He just wants honor. He wants to be first.



5 KEYS

I've summarized what I've learned in my 17 years of ministry into five steps that facilitate growth ministry.

1. If You Want a Successful Ministry, You Must Give It Everything You Have

So humble yourselves before God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.

James 4:7 NLT

And so, dear brothers and sisters, I plead with you to give your bodies to God because of all he has done for you. Let them be a living and holy sacrifice—the kind he will find acceptable. This is truly the way to worship him. Romans 12:1

Everyone wants a thriving ministry, but most people are not willing to give everything to get it. The starting point for success and growth in ministry is to decide that no matter what obstacle or distraction you face, you will remain steadfast. It is very important to have tunnel vision when it comes to the things God has spoken to you concerning your ministry and your life.

To be successful in whatever God tells you to do, you must be one-sided about where you're going and borderline stubborn about it. Although this kind of commitment will require everything you have, God will give you a grace to achieve it, and the joy of the Lord becomes your strength.

Well then, since God's grace has set us free from the law, does that mean we can go on sinning? Of course not! Don't you realize that you become the slave of whatever you choose to obey? You can be a slave to sin, which leads to death, or you can choose to obey God, which leads to righteous living.

Romans 6:15-16

The act of giving all of yourself to God demands that you become a slave. That sounds ugly, but it's true. Although you are no longer a slave to sin, you are still a slave—a slave of righteousness and a servant of the Most High God.

You must ask yourself about the motivation behind your ministry. If your priority isn't to be a great servant, you have it backward. We are not our own; we've been bought with a price. That means we are tasked with the honorable work of being a servant.

2. Understand the Holy Spirit Does the Heavy Lifting

When the Spirit of truth comes, he will guide you into all truth. He will not speak on his own but will tell you what he has heard. He will tell you about the future. John 16:13

Insecurity and bitterness can affect your ministry, so it is important to uproot them from your heart as you encounter challenging aspects of the ministry. As a minister, you will see what goes on behind the scenes of people's lives. It can get ugly—bad behaviors, bad habits, and transformations yet to take place in people's lives. If you allow what's ugly to permeate your heart and attempt to do the heavy lifting of correcting others, it will cause you damage.

It's the Holy Spirit who does the heavy lifting. All you have to do is pray. The Holy Spirit living inside of you means you have constant communication with the One who will help lead and guide you into all truth about everything concerning your life and your future.

When we fail to understand the Holy Spirit does the heavy lifting for us, we try to play His role and do things on our own. The consequences of attempting to do God's part in our own strength can be detrimental. The Bible says it's not by might nor by power, but it is by God's Spirit.

If you don't take advantage of the help of the Holy Spirit, and meddle in everyone's affairs, you will experience struggle. It's not your job to try to convince anyone to see things your way. Your only job is to preach the Word. When you spend your time confronting people about what they're doing wrong, their behavior won't change. They'll simply change how they act in front of you. No one will choose to live differently because you disapprove of their behavior. True change happens in the heart. A change of heart only comes from hearing the Gospel. Let the Word do its work in people's hearts and have confidence that the Word will affect change in people's lives.

3. Opportunity Has an Expiration Date

Make the most of every opportunity in these evil days. Don't act thoughtlessly, but understand what the Lord wants you to do. Ephesians 5:16-17

You must seize the day! When God presents you with opportunities, you have to take them and make them work. When doors open for you, it's a signal to move quickly and make the most of those opportunities. When the Lord opens a door and you don't walk through it, not only is there no guarantee it will be open again, but you have likely closed that door for good. The opportunity

of a lifetime must be seized in the lifetime of the opportunity. When the door opens and you make excuses not to walk through it or you drag your feet, it's an insult to God and the people God used to open the door for you.

Some people are so regimented that the Lord can't use them because they do not understand that being used by God requires flexibility. You stand out in ministry when you do things other people won't do, in a way other people won't do them. When you go the extra mile, you become an asset and not a liability. God can always find someone who will drop everything and go when the door opens, so let that person be you.



God provides opportunities for your promotion, so you cannot let opportunities slip out of your hands. You must seize them and move forward quickly. Your level of speed communicates your level of seriousness to God. When you drag your feet, you're telling God you're not serious about the opportunity He's giving you. When God gives you an opportunity it's a seed and a test for greater promotion. When God has placed a blessing in your possession and you pass the test, He will increase you. Actions prove your heart.



4. Don't Be an Island Unto Yourself—You Need Others

As iron sharpens iron, so a friend sharpens a friend. Proverbs 27:17

Staying in familiar environments cause you to be shortsighted—it blinds you. When you allow other believers to speak into your life, it sharpens you. The world of ministry is large and broad. Listening to other ministers with different anointings enables you to be

a well-rounded minister. Your brain is like a muscle. The more you use it and allow others to challenge your thoughts and ideas, the sharper you will become.

Most preachers will never attend any meeting unless they're preaching. But doing so is a sign of meekness and humility. Meekness is not weakness, and weakness is not timidity. Meekness is teachability.

5. Stay Anointed

You can be the least gifted person in the room, but nothing compares to someone who carries the anointing.

An anointed person might have a fraction of talent or ability, but the anointing makes all the difference in the world. Being anointed comes from spending time in God's presence. How much time you spend with the Lord in your secret place will be very apparent in the pulpit.

God hand selects an anointed person to undergo concentration and preservation. There is a tangible difference between an anointed person and a person who relies on their skills. It's evident in their passion for spending time in God's presence.

Fasting, praying, and reading the Word are good, but they do not replace spending time in God's presence and intimately fellowshiping with Him. If you're not hungry for God's presence, you can do all the right things on paper and they still won't work. The secret is to stay anointed.

What sets your ministry apart is the manifest power of the Holy Spirit. When you build your church on the Word of God and the demonstration of the Holy Spirit, you won't have to chase after people.

4 KEYS TO WINNING THE BATTLES OF LIFE!

No one is given a free run down the sideline of life. The Devil actively opposes God's people, but God has made provision for you to prevail in every battle of life.

The Word of God is simple. 1 John 5:3 says, "His commandments are not grievous." If you listen to God's Word and do what it says, you'll be set on high above all the nations of the world and experience all these blessings (Deuteronomy 28).

The Word of God is not a life raft designed to get you through life's storms. God's Word turns you into a holy storm that destroys every weapon the Devil has aligned against you. You may look like everyone else, but you're not like everyone else. You are in covenant with God.

Life doesn't give you what you deserve or some pre-ordained set of circumstances, life gives you what you demand from it based on God's Word.

If they obey and serve him, they shall spend their days in prosperity, and their years in pleasures. Job 36:11 (KJV)

Four Keys to Winning the Battles of Life

1. Never Mistake a Challenge for a Defeat

It's normal to be challenged, it's unscriptural to be defeated. It violates God's Word.

2. Immerse Yourself in Victorious Scriptures

Don't focus on the sympathetic and merciful scriptures in the Bible. They're in the Bible to help people who have endured unnecessary defeat, but they should not be your foundation. Instead, focus on scriptures like 1 John 5:4.

For whatsoever is born of God overcomes the world; and this is the victory that overcomes the world, even our faith.

3. Actively Resist the Devil

Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you. James 4:7 (KJV)

You have been delivered. The hold the Devil once had on you doesn't exist anymore. If he's not fleeing, you're not resisting. The Bible doesn't instruct you to beat or fight the Devil. He's already been defeated and he's in the exact same place today as he will be tomorrow—under your feet!

4. Respond with the Gift of Faith

Anything the Devil tries to discourage you from doing, do it twice. Push forward and refuse to take a single backward step. Any spirit challenging your ministry, health, or children will lose its head. You will be victorious not by might, not by power, but by the Spirit of almighty God.

But they hit a shoal and ran the ship aground too soon. The bow of the ship stuck fast, while the stern was repeatedly smashed by the force of the waves and began to break apart. The soldiers wanted to kill the prisoners to make sure they didn't swim ashore and escape. But the commanding officer wanted to spare Paul, so he didn't let them carry out their plan. Then he ordered all who could swim to jump overboard first and make for land. The others held on to planks or debris from the broken ship. So everyone escaped safely to shore. Acts 27:41-44 (NLT)



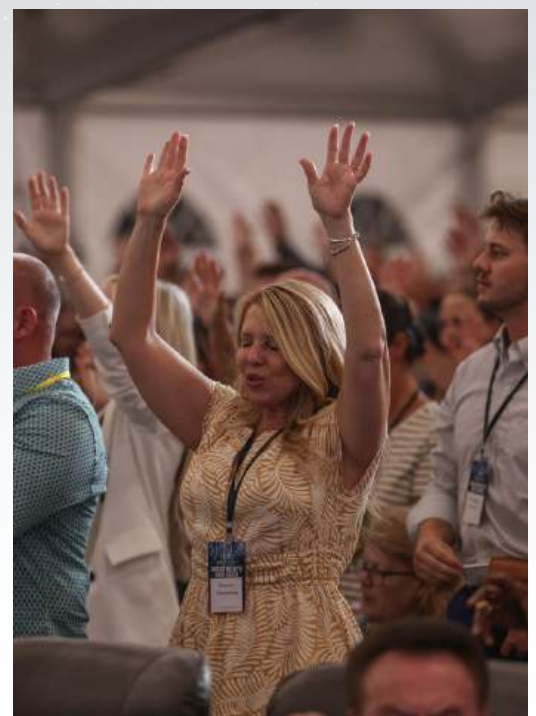

NEVER BACK DOWN FROM A FIGHT

As a Christian, you're in a battle whether you like it or not. The Bible calls us to fight the good fight of faith, and a good fight is the one you win. Winning requires you to fight until you experience victory.

You'll never win any battle if you don't carry yourself like a victor. Storms, trials, and tribulations will come, but they can only stop you if you allow it. Storms aren't designed to take you out; they're meant to make you a stronger fighter.

But thanks be to God, Who in Christ always leads us in triumph [as trophies of Christ's victory] and through us spreads and makes evident the fragrance of the knowledge of God everywhere

2 Corinthians 2:14 (AMPC)

You are Christ's trophy. You demonstrate to the world that God's people are not to be messed with because He is alive. So why are you troubled? Why can't you sleep? Why are you crying? You need the spirit of faith to come alive on the inside of you to walk in the reality of who you are in Christ. You can never be defeated. So, don't back down. Don't run from the fight. Square up!

Here are three keys to help you stand and fight.

1. Make up Your Mind to Never Be a Victim

Use every negative thing that has happened in your life as fuel to do something great. Don't strip yourself of power and responsibility by blaming the government, racism, or your family. Don't sit back and wait to see what God will do. You have the power to change your circumstances and be victorious through the blood of Jesus Christ.

2. Stop Feeling Sorry for Yourself

Self-pity only leads to depression. The world wallows and recounts everyone and every system that's wronged them. But the Word tells you to magnify God in every situation and expect to be victorious.

The source of every struggle and failure is Satan—not God. That should make you angry. The Devil is merciless. His only purpose is to kill and destroy you and your family. Fight back with a vicious and relentless pursuit of everything God said belongs to you.

3. Change the Game

If you don't make any changes, nothing will change. Living the life of Christ is not difficult because He gave us His Word. All you need to do is crack it open, read it, obey it, and apply it. That's living by faith.

Never confess anything that would put you in a state of defeat and failure. When you side with the Word, triumph is inevitable. The Devil will attempt to intimidate and deceive you, but when you allow God to be God and carry on as though the Devil can't touch you, God will always show Himself faithful to you and your family.

The life of Christ is easy. Living a life apart from Christ is what's hard. But you have the hand of God leading and guiding you. That's His promise to you. You never have to be scared or defeated. You reign in victory with your elder brother Jesus by your side. You never have to run from a fight.

But a man of God came to him, saying, “O king, do not let the army of Israel go with you, for the Lord is not with Israel—not with any of the children of Ephraim. But if you go, be gone! Be strong in battle! Even so, God shall make you fall before the enemy; for God has power to help and to overthrow.” Then Amaziah said to the man of God, “But what shall we do about the hundred talents which I have given to the troops of Israel?” And the man of God answered, “The Lord is able to give you much more than this. 2 Chronicles 25:7-8 NKJV

Too many believers have been held to a certain level. They’re content to stay the same. So, they write theology that accommodates mediocrity. Something inside them feels small is good, but the Devil is a liar. They’ve been postponing their blessing. You must know that everything you’ve seen is not comparable to where God will take you.

Now to Him who is able to [carry out His purpose and] do superabundantly more than all that we dare ask or think [infinitely beyond our greatest prayers, hopes, or dreams], according to His power that is at work within us.
Ephesians 3:20 AMP

God is able to do much more than this because He told you as much in Ephesians 3:20. **‘Much more than this’** means greater expectations, works, healings, miracles, favors, and open doors. Much more than

this means greater opportunities, growth, achievements, and success.

He sought God in the days of Zechariah, who had understanding in the visions of God; and as long as he sought the Lord, God made him prosper. 2 Chronicles 26:5 NKJV

We’re always enthralled by the testimonies of people who carried revivals in the United States throughout the 40s and 50s — the days of William Branham and Maria Woodworth-Etter, but God is not concerned about what happened yesterday. He’s about to do a new thing. Much more than this.

For God to do much more than this, you must face situations that are beyond your abilities. If you never face anything, it’s because God doesn’t trust you. When you experience challenges it’s not a rejection, it’s a sign that God believes in you, and it’s proof that something awesome is about to enter your life. Much more than this means when God steps in, something beyond your imagination is about to happen.

God always takes so He can bless, break, and multiply. That’s the reason things leave your hand. God takes them so He can bless, break, and multiply them. When He multiplied the boy’s lunch, He fed thousands until there were twelve baskets remaining, one for every month of the year.

When He had stopped speaking, He said to Simon, “Launch out into the deep and let down your nets for a catch.” But Simon

answered and said to Him, “Master, we have toiled all night and caught nothing; nevertheless at Your word I will let down the net.” And when they had done this, they caught a great number of fish, and their net was breaking. So they signaled to their partners in the other boat to come and help them. And they came and filled both the boats, so that they began to sink. Luke 5:4-7 NKJV

The challenge of life is when you toil without the presence of God. A toiling spirit is not an anointing, it’s working hard without results.

In every nation and culture, the night is symbolic of pressure and the terrible demonic realm, but Jesus came into Peter’s boat and said, “Throw your net.” The simplicity of the Word of God brings deliverance to the believer. It may seem simplistic, but when God steps into His Word, He can turn everything around. It is foolishness to man, but it is the revelation of the power of God.

When Jesus told Peter to throw his net, Peter put all the arguments aside, obeyed Jesus’ instructions, and let down the net. When Peter obeyed Jesus’ instructions, the Bible says he pulled from the net, much more than this.

Ye are the salt of the earth: but if the salt have lost his savour, wherewith shall it be salted? it is thenceforth good for nothing, but to be cast out, and to be trodden under foot of men. Ye are the light of the world. A city that is set on an hill cannot be hid. Neither do men light a candle, and put it under a bushel, but on a candlestick; and it giveth light unto all that are in the house. Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven. Matthew 5:13-16 KJV

"Good for nothing" is the worst description you can receive. Jesus used the term about the state of believers and the Church. When the Body of Christ has lost its saltiness, the taste and the flavor we are supposed to bring into the world, Jesus classifies us as "good for nothing," and ready to be thrown out.

The Church is the light and salt of America. Don't shy away from your role as the flavor of your nation because no one else can do what The Church does. There is no organization, school, orphanage, university, institution, or political party that brings the flavor that the Church brings to the Earth. You must make an effort to count for something when it comes to the work of God.

And he said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature. Mark 16:15-16 KJV

Our job as believers is to preach the Gospel. When preaching is reduced to lectures and motivational speaking, the real flavor we have been called to bring into this world is lost and we become good for nothing. No organization has been mandated and instructed to pray for people, heal the sick, and preach the Gospel to all nations, that is the job of the Church alone. If the Church is no longer preaching to every nation, we have lost our flavor.

You will not enjoy anything in life with a one-leg-in-and-one-leg-out mentality. If you don't give church and ministry everything you have, you'll never enjoy the fullness of it. You are good for something, and you must strive to become the person God's called you to be and do the things God has called you to do.

And he divided unto them his living. And not many days after the younger son gathered all together, and took his journey into a far country,

and there wasted his substance with riotous living. And when he had spent all, there arose a mighty famine in that land; and he began to be in want. Luke 15:12-14 KJV

The prodigal son ended up with nothing because he walked away from the father God gave him. A father is someone who helps you become who you are supposed to be. In 1 Corinthians 4:15 Paul said, "You have 10,000 instructors, but not many are fathers; for in Christ Jesus, I have begotten you." Churches become good for nothing when people dishonor their spiritual fathers.

But a certain Samaritan, as he journeyed, came where he was: and when he saw him, he had compassion on him, and went to him, and bound up his wounds, pouring in oil and wine, and set him on his own beast, and brought him to an inn, and took care of him. Luke 10:33-34 KJV

The story of the good Samaritan illustrates how people can be good for nothing. A priest and a Levite passed by a man lying on the roadside, but only the Samaritan stopped and showed compassion. God is raising up the Church to show compassion to the world again. When we have compassion and love for people with difficulties that makes us good for something.

And seeing a fig tree afar off having leaves, he came, if haply he might find any thing thereon: and when he came to it, he found nothing but leaves; for the time of figs was not yet. Mark 11:13 KJV

Your excuses won't work when Jesus comes to you looking for fruit. When you're not ready to bear fruit, be ready for a curse. We have a short time to be fruitful. When Jesus approaches us, we must be ready to produce fruit. Your fruit must come at the right time because you can't tell God to come back later. The time to bear fruit is now. Today, God wants to bless you. He wants you to be useful and He wants to use your one talent. God has chosen you, all you must do is pray for the opportunity to be used by Him.

The true purpose for man's existence is intimacy with God. God never created man to be independent of his Maker. God said, *"These people have I formed for my pleasure"* (Isaiah 43:21). You didn't decide to be created, so you cannot decide how to live. God created man for fellowship (Genesis 3:8), and as a result, man was designed to reside in the presence of God.



In Scripture, those who chose the way of intimacy with God made the most of their lives. Enoch walked with God, and he was never found. He walked with God until he disappeared in God. Abraham stood in God's presence (Genesis 17:21). Moses saw God's power when He divided the Red Sea, but He refused to move forward without the presence of God. (Exodus 33:15). Joshua, Moses' servant, followed the same path. He stayed at the foot of the mountain as Moses went up to meet with God. (Exodus 33:14-18). Regardless of where you are today, you are being called to walk closer with God.

"As the Lord God of Israel liveth, before whom I stand, there shall not be dew or rain these years, but according to my word" (1 Kings 17:1). Notice Elijah said, "Before whom I stand," not visit. You must stand with God to stand on Earth. In the physical, Elijah was standing before King Ahab, but in the spirit, he was standing before God. And Elijah walked in a realm that caused both nature and creation to bow before him.

"There was a man sent from God, whose name was John" (John 1:6). John the Baptist wasn't sent by God, he was sent from God. God became the location where John resided. He lived in God. Many are sent by God, but few are sent from God. Very few people live in God, but God was John's residential address. Where do you reside? In the days of John the Baptist, individuals came out to hear a person preach, but John resided in God, and when he preached entire cities came to hear him. *"Then went out to him Jerusalem, and all Judea, and all the region round about the Jordan"* (Matthew 3:5). The level of command and control you exact on your generation is determined by your proximity to God.

He said, I am the voice of one crying out in the wilderness, Make straight the way of the Lord, as said the prophet Esaias. John 1:23

John the Baptist lived in God until he was no longer a person, but the voice of God. He used to be a person when he lived outside of God, but once he resided in God, he became an expression. John was a mobile revelation. He stayed in God until God turned him into His message. His life communicated a message and revelation. When people see you, what do they hear? Your proximity to also God determines the perception people have of you.

What is Intimacy with God?

1. Addiction to God's Presence

Intimacy with God causes you to be miserable without His presence. You'll experience withdrawal symptoms. You are no longer interested in whatever God is not involved in.

2. Addiction to the Voice of God

The voice of God comes out of His Word. His voice is pleasurable to your soul. Before you ingest physical food, eat spiritual food. When money enters your hand, use it for God first, before you spend any for yourself. When you wake up in the morning, talk to God before anyone else. *"But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness and all these things shall be added unto you"* (Matthew 6:33).

3. Commitment to Communion

Exchange thoughts and desires with God. It's the act of telling God what's on your mind and listening as God tells you what is on His mind. Most of us do the first part – we tell God what's on our mind and then run off. But God is interested in telling you what He's thinking.

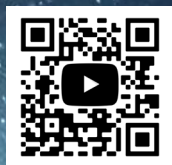
4. Commitment to His Pleasure

When you're intimate with God you want to please Him with your life. You never want to do anything to misrepresent Him. You strive, as Jesus did, to hear, "Here is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased."

5. Commitment to Walk with God

Walking with God means: First, to keep company with God. Second, to go God's way instead of your own. Third, to have an unhidden identity with God.

When you are intimate with God, it becomes impossible for anyone to claim they didn't know you belong to God. You become notoriously spiritual. When you fellowship with the Consuming Fire you become fire – it takes fire to walk with fire. Intimacy with God makes you spiritually intense. May you be filled with fresh fire and enter into the next level in your relationship with God in the name of Jesus.

The flesh cannot please God. Faith operates in the spirit. Faith can bless your flesh, but it's not a manifestation of the flesh. Without faith, you can't please God. It has nothing to do with your flesh, it's a spiritual exercise.

FF Bosworth once said, "The outpouring of the Holy Spirit will be in exact proportion to the power of the Holy Spirit praying through us." If we apply this sentiment to the end-time revival, the effects it will have in your life are based on your prayer life. Another preacher told me this way, "No prayer, no power; some prayer, some power; much prayer, much power."

Where do wars and fights come from among you? Do they not come from your desires for pleasure that war in your members? James 4:1

When you pray God will show you a path forward. The older I get, the more I realize that God customizes a pathway to success for every individual. God doesn't use us all in the same way. God created you with a unique set of fingerprints and He tailor-made your pathway to victory. It belongs to you, personally. The burden is on you to answer the call of prayer for your own life.

Your flesh is what stands between you and your pathway to victory. The Devil doesn't have as much power as most Christians would give him credit. The number one problem in your life stares back at you in the mirror every day.

The flesh wars against the spirit. You can become filled with the Word of God, but without the corresponding anointing of the Spirit, the Word won't work for you. Your flesh battles the anointing, but God will help you die to yourself, crucify your flesh, and pray until the Spirit of the Lord takes prominence in your spirit and your flesh dies out.

You are responsible for bringing revival into the world by your prayer. We pray it into existence.

We Can Block Our Prayer Power

Ye lust, and have not: ye kill, and desire to have, and cannot obtain: ye fight and war, yet ye have not, because ye ask not. Ye ask, and receive not, because ye ask amiss, that ye may consume it upon your lusts. James 4:2-3

Wrong prayer is rooted in wrong desires. Anytime you place material things above your soul, you're

praying incorrectly. "But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you" (Matthew 6:33). God doesn't care about the car you drive, the clothes you wear, or the house you live in as long as your priority is Jesus, His Kingdom, and His anointing. Don't allow anyone to talk you out of the blessing of God, it's a natural byproduct of seeking God first.

Or do you think that the Scripture says in vain, "The Spirit who dwells in us yearns jealously"? But He gives more grace. Therefore He says: "God resists the proud, But gives grace to the humble." James 4:5-6

I like to define grace as God's Redeeming Action Concerning Everything. Grace is what moves us from the flesh into the path of victory. Sometimes correction means God is getting ready to promote you. If you humble yourself, God will exalt you in due season because you're on a path to victory

The Pathway to Victory

Therefore submit to God. Resist the devil and he will flee from you. 8 Draw near to God and He will draw near to you. Cleanse your hands, you sinners; and purify your hearts, you double-minded. James 4:7-8

Double-mindedness occurs when you allow your flesh to rule your spirit. When you make the spirit the ruler of your life, double-mindedness is eliminated. It's time to return to the old-fashioned altar and crucify the flesh until the prayer of the saints changes the circumstances of the nation.

There is an anointing that only comes from prayer. Get filled with the Holy Ghost. Pray in tongues every day. Pray in the Spirit, then pray with understanding. Understanding comes after you've prayed in the Holy Ghost.

In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth. And the earth was without form, and void; and darkness was upon the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God moved upon the face of the waters. Genesis 1:1-2 KJV

The reason God created the heavens and the Earth was to reveal a side of Himself that Satan did not know.

And a river went out of Eden to water the garden; and from thence it was parted, and became into four heads. The name of the first is Pison: that is it which compasseth the whole land of Havilah, where there is gold; And the gold of that land is good: there is bdellium and the onyx stone. And the name of the second river is Gihon: the same is it that compasseth the whole land of Ethiopia. And the name of the third river is Hiddekel: that is it which goeth toward the east of Assyria. And the fourth river is Euphrates. Genesis 2:10 KJV

The God we serve is a God of rivers. He uses the river to reveal another side of Himself that not all Creation knows. The Scriptures say there was a river that parted into four riverheads. When Satan saw these four riverheads, he realized that he could cross them to get to man. The first riverhead was called Pison, where there was gold and precious stones. Satan can traverse over any money or wealth you possess to reach you. The second river, Gihon, is where King David ordered his son, Solomon, to be taken to receive the anointing. Satan can cross over the anointing and any position you possess to reach you.

The third River, Hiddekel, was where Daniel prayed a prayer of intercession when battling the Prince of Persia. No matter how prayerful you are, Satan can cross over to reach you. The fourth river, Euphrates, is where the future

battle of Armageddon will take place. Satan can see your future and cross over to it. Satan said, "I will cross these four rivers and get to man," but he forgot that Jehovah is not a God of four, but a God of five. There is another side of God that the Devil does not know. No one fights with four fingers. The moment someone turns a fifth finger, it becomes a fist that can be used to knock the Devil out.

Although God reserved the four rivers for the Devil's knowledge, there was another river that came from Emmanuel's side. When they pierced Jesus, water and blood poured out of His side and on the cross at Calvary, God released that river. There is another side of God that Satan does not know.

There is a river, the streams whereof shall make glad the city of God, the holy place of the tabernacles of the most High. Psalm 46:4 KJV

Moses didn't deliver the children of Israel by drawing a sword but by the mighty hand of God. The Israelites were bound for 430 years without anyone to save them. God saw this and after meeting Moses on Mount Sinai, God turned him into a new man.

Moses is an Egyptian name that means *to pull or draw out of water*, but God called him as a deliverer to show Egypt a side of God that it did not know. He made Moses a god to Pharaoh. Although Moses had trouble believing in the mission from the beginning, he carried it out by believing God.

And I will put enmity between thee and the woman, and between thy seed and her seed; it shall bruise thy head, and thou shalt bruise his heel. Genesis 3:15 KJV

The promise of Jesus as the Messiah was a miracle because God promised to do something the world had never seen before. Biologically, a woman has no seed. When God said the seed of a woman would crush the Devil's head, He revealed another side of Himself the Devil did not know.

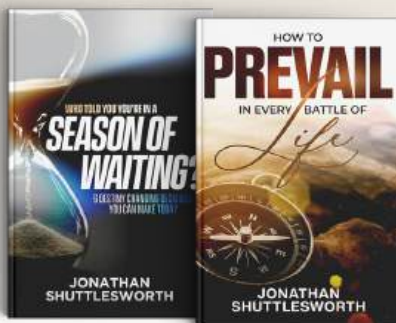

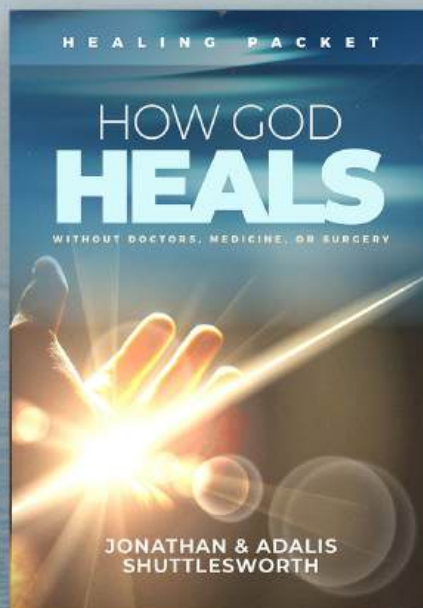
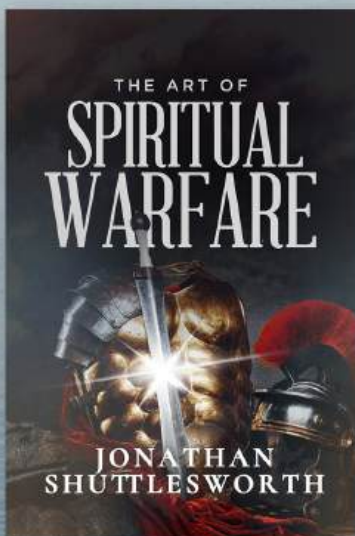
