#### WHAT SPECIFIC CAREER CHALLENGES DID YOU HAVE, THAT LED YOU TO LOOK FOR A SOLUTION LIKE LBT?

The company I work for went through a merger and acquisition three years ago. The usual transitional challenges that come with this were compounded by a very buoyant market, meaning that talent retention is a challenge but also vital.

I wanted to make sure I was doing all I could to help build a dedicated and stable team of high performers. In terms of my own career progression, I was looking for some insights to help me progress in the company.

#### WHAT ABOUT THE PROGRAM EXCEEDED, MET OR DIDN'T MEET YOUR EXPECTATIONS?

It was a well-balanced course, and reinforced that what I was doing in a lot of areas was the correct approach.
