***Devotions from Sister Monica Clare, the 'TikTok' Nun***

This year's Lenten devotional series is based upon a series of Lenten daily Bible devotions written by an Episcopalian nun and unlikely TikTok star, Sister Monica Clare (you can check her out at @nunsenseforthepeople).

Before taking vows in 2012, Sister Monica's path looked very different: she worked as a photo editor in Los Angeles, performed in an acoustic rock duo and trained with the renowned Groundlings improv comedy group. In June 2021, she launched her TikTok presence not to seek fame, but to share joy, break stereotypes about religious life and offer hope in a world often marked by cynicism.

This series will be offered in-person and online, via Zoom, as I hope to include as many as possible in this study. Our 1st Zoom meeting will begin on **Wednesday, Feb, 25th at 7:00 pm**. Our 1st in-person meeting will be **Thursday, Feb. 26th at 11:00 am**, after the prayer service in the chapel. Snacks and other light refreshments will be served at the in-person gatherings.

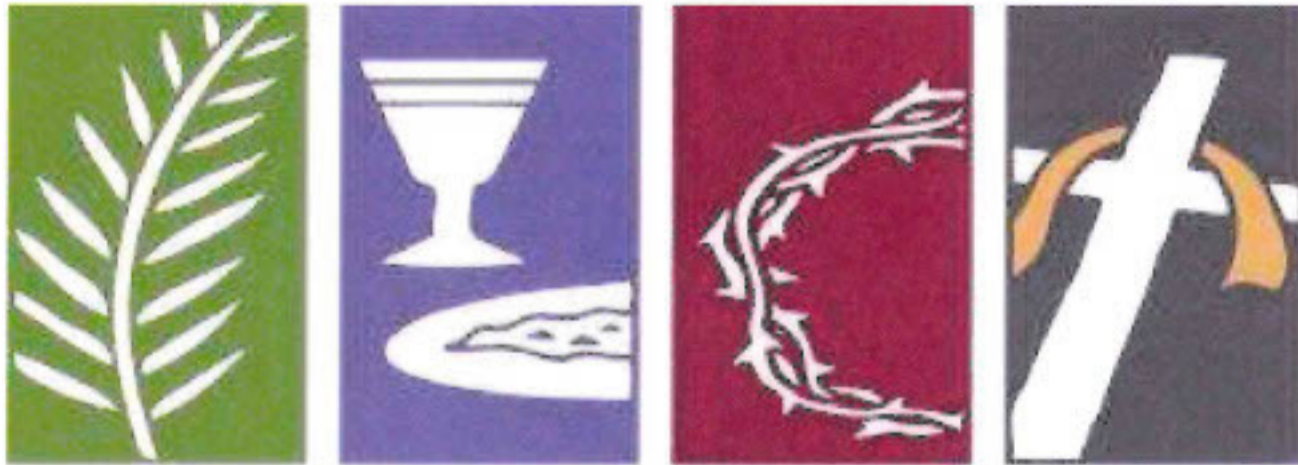

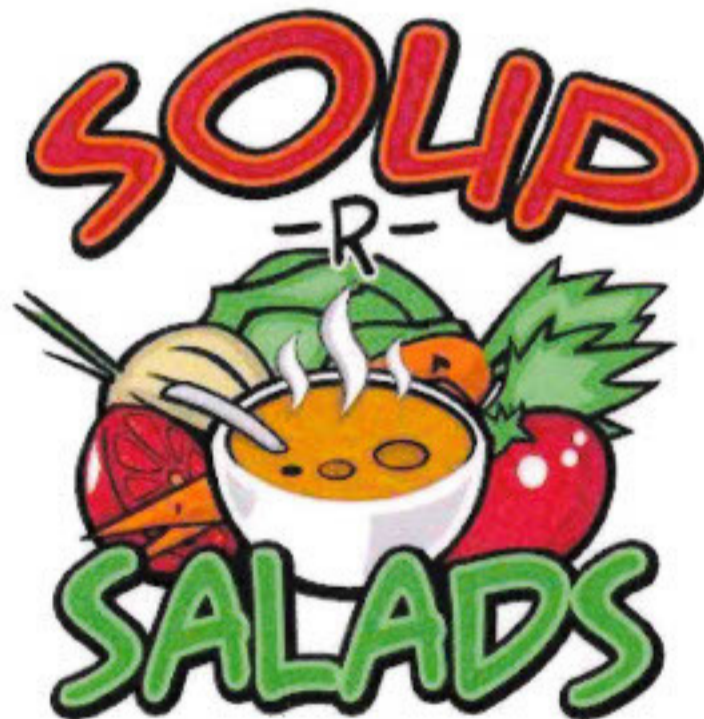
