GIRLS DRESS CODE

Pre-K3/K4

Appropriate girl's attire will be blouses, skirts, jumpers and dresses. Skirt and dress lengths need to be at the **bottom of the knee always**, whether sitting or standing (*leggings and pants must not be considered in the length of the skirt*). No sleeveless attire. No graphic t-shirts.

K/5 through 12th Grades [students are required to wear uniform]

<u>Skirts</u>: Plaid Skirts must be purchased for all girls K5- 12th grade. They can be purchased through landsend.com or frenchtoast.com.

Lands End Color: Hunter Classic Navy Plaid (plaid pleated skirt below the knee)

French Toast Color: Green Plaid (plaid pleated skirt below the knee) All skirts must be to the bottom of the knee always, whether standing or sitting. Spandex-type shorts may be worn under skirts for PE or recess if they are no longer than the top of the knee.

Blouses: Forest/Hunter green, black, and white polos. Proper undergarments are to be worn always. All undershirts must be white and should not be visible. Shirts must be tucked in always. **Shirts must be embroidered. **

Shoes: All shoes must be one to two solid color(s). Tennis shoes, casual shoes, and dress shoes are permissible if they meet the requirements. (no patterns/multicolored/fuzzy shoes) (no slipper-like shoes)

<u>Jackets</u>: only those from Allistons are allowed. Allistons in Gulfport sells jackets (already embroidered) in stock in store (228-832-8683) or online.

<u>Socks and Hosiery:</u> All socks, tights and leotards must be one of the following solid colors: black, white, brown or navy blue. All socks and hosiery must be solid with no designs. NO athletic leggings, or leggings with any design are permitted.

<u>Hair:</u> Hair must be neat, clean, and natural in appearance. Fad hairdos, cuts, colors, streaking, and chunking are not permitted. Highlights or lowlights are permitted if they blend with the natural color of the hair. Bangs must be cut above the eyebrows. Extreme designs, partially shaved patches, or completely shaven heads are not acceptable. Feathers and/or other material worn or woven into hair is not permissible.

<u>Makeup and Jewelry:</u> Makeup and jewelry must be conservative. Girls in Kindergarten through 6th grades may not wear makeup of any kind during school hours or at any school-sponsored programs. No more than two piercings are allowed in the ear, and both must be in ear lobe (piercings are not permitted in the upper ear or other parts of the body).

BOYS DRESS CODE

Pre-K3/K4

Appropriate boy's attire must be khaki or denim pants and a nice-looking t-shirt, polo shirt, or dress shirt. No sleeveless attire. No sweatpants or athletic-type pants. No graphic t-shirts.

K/5 through 12th Grades [students are required to wear uniform.]

<u>Pants</u>: Khaki colored pants. Belts are to be worn always. *Pants may be purchased from any local or online store*.

<u>Shirts:</u> Forest/Hunter green, black, and white polos. Proper undergarments are to be worn always. All undershirts must be white and should not be visible. Shirts must be tucked in always.

**Shirts must be embroidered. **

<u>Shoes:</u> All shoes must be one to two solid color(s). Tennis shoes, casual shoes, anddress shoes are permissible if they meet the requirements. (no patterns/multicolored/fuzzy shoes) (no slipper-like shoes)

<u>Jackets</u>: only those from Allistons are allowed. Allistons in Gulfport sells jackets (already embroidered) in stock in store (228-832-8683) or online.

Hair: Haircuts must be tapered on the back and sides to follow the natural line of the skull. The bulk of the hair must not exceed three and a half inches at any point. No tails will be allowed. Hair must be neat, clean, and natural in appearance. No "fad" hairdos, cuts, colors, streaking, or chunking are permitted. Line cuts in the hair, shaved portions, bowl cuts, hair dyed with peroxide, or any radical styles or fashions are not allowed. All young men must be clean-shaven. No mustaches or beards will be permitted. Sideburns can be no longer than to the middle of the ears. Boys that are not clean-shaven must be picked up by the parents and will not be allowed to return until clean-shaven. Razors will not be provided.

Boys are **not** permitted to wear earrings, necklaces, other ladies' jewelry, or apparel pertaining to ladies' wear at any time.
