DATE NIGHT IN BOX | LET'S ADVENTURE

How to play Scattergories

- 1. Your game will consist of 6 lists; 4 that we have provided for you and 2 that you can create on your own.
- 2. To play each list, pick a letter and start a 3-minute timer. Once a letter has been used, put it to the side so that you don't use the same letter twice.
- 3. The object of the game is to come up with an answer that begins with the chosen letter for each category on the list. Answers must begin with that letter; articles (a/an/the) do not count. Players are not allowed to use the same answer more than once on a list. An answer does not count if the player's opponent wrote the same answer. Answers can be creative but must be accepted by the other player.
- 4. Once the timer runs out, take turns reading your answers for each category on the list. Circle each acceptable answer that does not match any other player's answers. Continue working your way down the list until all categories have been marked. Each circled answer is 1 point, write your total score for each list at the top of the column on your answer sheet.
- 5. Continue picking new letters for each new list.
- 6. After all 6 lists have been completed, the player with the most points wins the game. In the case of a tie, repeat list 1 with a new letter!

OBJECT: Beat the timer by filling out a category list with answers that begin with the chosen letter. Score points if no other player matches your answers. To win the game, score the most points.

We have included additional cards for you to continue playing if you so choose.
