The school recently completed a 9,000 square foot addition which provided additional upper school classrooms, bathrooms, office space, and storage. In addition, the school completed a campus redevelopment in 2024, adding a new athletic field, storm water management, and parking. Our suburban location is 45-60 minutes northwest of Philadelphia, 20 minutes from historic Valley Forge and 45 minutes from Lancaster, PA.
