

The History

Built in 1867, originally as a deterrent to Napoleon III, Polhawn Fort was designed with strength, security and longevity in mind. The threat of a hostile landing on Whitsand Bay was over before the build was complete, so the Fort has never seen battle. Since then, the building has been reimagined as a private home, guest house, hotel and wedding venue.

A family owned and managed venue, Polhawn Fort's approach is friendly and free-spirited. We believe weddings and events should be fun and a true expression of yourself. That's why we try to keep rules and restrictions to a minimum, allowing you to use the space as you wish.

Winter Weddings

Built with 8-feet deep, granite walls, The Fort is designed to weather all seasons. Winter weddings here bring a new vibe, where cosy comfort and log fires become the order of the day. The wild coastal storms and pared-back nature are enjoyed from within.

Between the snow and rain, Cornwall's microclimate provides plenty of sunshine year-round for brisk walks along the beach and outdoor photo opportunities.

Summerhouse + Lawn



Capacity - Seated: 100

On a summer's day, there is nowhere more romantic to say your vows than our Summerhouse. Positioned cliffside between the Fort and the ocean with far-reaching views, the Summerhouse is fully licensed for outdoor wedding ceremonies.

Once the formalities are finished, our manicured lawns overlooking the secluded cove offer ample space for outdoor marquee receptions and dining all fresco. Fort's Halls



Capacity - Seated: up to 100 | Standing: up to 100

For indoor weddings, The Fort offers two inviting spaces for your special day. Larger parties can be hosted in the Grand Napoleonic Hall seating up to 120 guests, while the Ocean Room is ideal for small, intimate weddings of up to 30 guests.

The warm, earthy tones of the Fort's natural stone provide a blank canvas for your event. Style the space with elaborate floral displays or keep it understated and let the Fort's natural beauty become the backdrop.

The Terrace



Capacity - Seated: Options for 57, 64 and 80 guests | Standing: 100

Perfect for pre or post ceremony gatherings, The Terrace is a stretch-tent space on the roof of the Fort. Decorated with fairy lights and surrounded by lush vegetation, it's the ideal place to relax and reminisce.

Due to our coastal location and occasional strong winds, there may be times when The Terrace is unavailable. Guests will be notified 24 hours before your event should adverse weather conditions affect the use of the space.

The Fort can comfortably sleep 16 across 8 bedrooms, all with beautiful garden and sea views. Three suites (Ocean, Wave and Moon) are located on the ground floor with a further five bedrooms (Pebble, Shell, Ripple, Surf and Sand) on the lower floor.

Our spacious bedrooms feature vaulted ceilings, super king or twin beds with ultracomfortable Vispring mattresses and 100% Egyptian cotton linen. Most rooms have ensuite bathrooms too stocked with organic, Cornish toiletries.

All bedrooms at Polhawn Fort come with tea and coffee facilities.

An additional 8 guests can be accommodated on request.




Recharge and rekindle away from the hustle of home.
