

### Learning Guide Create a Personal Website with 3D Animations Using Weebly

### Introduction

Weebly is a global platform that allows users to create their own unique websites, blogs, or online stores for free. While Weebly allows users to create their own code to build web pages, you don't need to know how to code to create a website with Weebly. Many elements of the website are customizable with drag and drop options. This Guide will show you how to incorporate 3D animations you've created into a dynamic website using Weebly.

### Step 1: Set up your website

### Preview

This step will show you how to set up your own website in Weebly. If you already own a website, you can jump to the second step, but keep in mind that this Guide uses instructions based on Weebly's design.

### **Experiment**

#### **CREATE A WEEBLY ACCOUNT**

Go to Weebly on https://www.weebly.com.

Log in or sign up to create an account.

Choose the option to create a personal website.

#### **CHOOSE A THEME**

Follow the prompts to select a **Personal** theme that fits the needs of your website. You will be able to customize the theme further after creating your own domain.



You can click on a theme to see it on a larger screen. When you're happy with the theme you've picked, click on **Start Editing** on the top-right. ×

#### **SET A DOMAIN**

Use a unique domain name for your website and make sure it's available.

Professional domains only have a 1-year free trial. Make sure to pick the **Subdomain** option at the bottom for the free Weebly domain option.

If you're planning to use your website as a portfolio source, it's a good idea to keep your domain name professional. You can always edit your domain name later in Weebly settings.

### Step 2: Edit elements on your website

### Preview

After creating a domain and website, you can customize it as much as you wish. Weebly offers tools and templates to help you build your website to your own specifications.

### Experiment

#### DRAG AND DROP ELEMENTS

Weebly uses a drag-and-drop interface to help the user customize their site with images, text blocks, slideshows, and galleries.

For example, you can add a section with custom text to your homepage by dragging the "**Text**" element from the left menu onto the desired spot on your webpage. Double click on the added text block to customize it as you wish.

If you'd like to move the different elements on your page, hover over the element and click-drag on the white box that appears at the middle-top of the element.

If the theme you've chosen comes with default images, you can click on the image elements and pick the **Edit Image** or **Replace Image** option to make changes to the default template to fit your needs.

Feel free to explore different tools and options offered in Weebly to customize and personalize your website.

#### **CREATE A NEW PAGE**

Create a new page that will showcase your 3D animation.

Head to the **Pages** section on the top menu bar and click on the **+ icon** on the left to create a new page.





From the dropdown options, select "Standard Page".

Give your page a name that will be displayed on your website, and click **Done**.





Head back to the **Build** tab from the top menu. Open your newly created page in the editing viewport.





#### **EMBED YOUR SPLINE CODE**

Drag the "**Embed Code**" element from the left-hand menu to where you want the 3D model to appear on the new page.

Click on the code block you've added to your page and select the **Edit Custom HTML** option.

Paste the embed code you've copied from Spline.

By default, the Spline animation will show up as a small bar on the editing page instead of being full-size. Follow the next steps to publish your website to be able to see the Spline animation in full and be able to interact in the way you set up.

### Step 3: Publish your website

### Preview

When you're ready to test your website or make it available to the public, you can publish it on Weebly. This will allow anyone to be able to find your site on the web and visit it.

### Experiment



#### PUBLISH

Once you're happy with your site, click the blue **Publish** button on the top right corner.

Click on the published link to open your website in a new tab.

Your website is now live with the embedded 3D Spline animation. You can watch or trigger your animations the same way you've set up in Spline.

If you make changes to your website in Weebly, make sure to publish again so the changes update on your website.







If you make changes to your animation back in Spline, you do not need to copy and paste a new embed code. The project should update automatically.

However, if you notice that the project is not updating as expected, this might be due to the cookies and cache in your browser, and you can fix the issue by clearing them.

If you're using Chrome, click on the 3-dot icon on the top-right corner of your browser to open **More Settings** and select the **Delete Browsing Data** option.



In the basic tab, make sure all settings are selected and pick your time range. If you've been using Spline or Weebly for a long time, it's suggested that you pick the "All time" option to be safe. Keep in mind that deleting browsing data will log you out of all of your accounts.

When ready, click on **Delete Data**.

When you log back into Weebly, your Spline animation should be updated automatically.
