## **BODY CONTOURING**

#### Are results permanent from body contouring treatments?

Results are permanent as long as you are maintaining a well balanced diet and exercise along with body contouring treatments.

#### How often do I need to come in to maintain the results?

The body contouring treatments are set up in either a 6 or 12-package. You'll be required to come in on a once a week basis to maintain results.

#### Are the treatments painful?

#### How do I know if I'm a good candidate for body contouring?

During your phone consultation, we will discuss your health history and assess your active lifestyle to determine which body contouring treatment best suits you. We will also inquire about your current medical condition to determine whether or not you can receive body contouring treatments. If you are unsure about body contouring treatments please consult with your medical physician to receive a clearance on body contouring treatments before booking.

## BRAZILIAN POST SURGERY LYMPHATIC DRAINAGE MASSAGE

#### Does the post-surgery lymphatic drainage massage hurt?

No! This massage focuses on helping to facilitate the movement of stagnant lymphatic fluid within the lymphatic system by using light, gentle strokes.

#### How many massages should I be receiving?

The recommendation is to receive 20- 40 massages for your first 3 months of healing. So make sure to financially plan for your post-op care. As someone who has had cosmetic surgery and also went through a negative experience, I stress the importance of the post-surgery lymphatic drainage massage. The more massages you get, the better you will feel and your results will be a lot more enhanced!

#### When should I start booking my massages?

As soon as you book your surgeon, book your post-surgery lymphatic massages in advance! You should never wait until the last minute to book out your post-op lymphatic massages due to a facility being booked out and not having the availability that you need.

#### How long should I have to wait to receive my first massage?

Most of the time surgeons will suggest that you receive massages 24 hours after your surgery. But if your surgeon says to wait for specific reasons, please listen to them and wait until you have clearance to receive your post-op lymphatic massage.

## **MASSAGE THERAPY**

#### How do I know which massage service will benefit my needs?

During your consultation with your massage therapist, they will analyze your verbal concerns and give you the best recommendation of the service that will help target your goals.

#### What is the difference between firm pressure and a Deep Tissue massage?

Our Deep Tissue massage focuses on specifically targeting areas that are causing chronic pain whereas a firm pressure Swedish massage combines relaxation of Swedish techniques with stronger pressure.
