Mentimeter FAQ

1. What is Mentimeter?

<u>Mentimeter</u> is an interactive presentation tool that allows Brittany to gather real-time feedback from audience members during her keynote and share results onscreen. It's a fun, engaging way for everyone to participate in — and co-create the content of — her keynotes, making each one truly one of a kind.

2. How will Brittany present her Mentimeter presentation at my event?

Mentimeter is a web-based presentation platform. She will log into her Mentimeter.com account and present live from the web. Most AV crews prefer Brittany log in on one of their machines, but she also travels with her own laptop if needed. **There are no slides to download ahead of time.**

3. What else does my AV team need to know/do?

Brittany will log into Mentimeter.com during AV check. She prefers to use the house slide advancer (PerfectCue or similar), with which Mentimeter.com is compatible. As a backup, she can advance slides from an app on her phone.

Brittany requires a confidence monitor in front of the stage to view responses. It should match the slide view audiences see. Additionally, Brittany will bring an iPad to place onstage to view the next slide.

A hard-wired internet connection is preferred but not necessary. Brittany travels with a mobile hotspot. There is no audio and no moving video in the presentation — only slides.

4. Will Brittany use the Mentimeter PowerPoint integration?

No. Brittany does not use the PowerPoint integration with Mentimeter. This is not negotiable.

5. Can I see my audience's responses on Mentimeter during/after the presentation?

Yes! Attendees will see audience members' responses in real time. After the keynote, Brittany can provide a PDF of the presentation that includes all of the results captured from participants.

6. Can I test out the Mentimeter presentation before Brittany arrives for her tech check?

Your AV team can test the functionality of the Mentimeter presentation with a test link and/or demo account provided by Brittany's team. However, Brittany will still need to log into her account (not the test account) on the day of the keynote to present. Brittany can also send a PDF of her slides before her presentation for your team to review content.

7. Can my virtual audience members participate in the Mentimeter presentation?

Yes. Mentimeter works great for hybrid audiences! Virtual attendees can use their phones to join the presentation, just as the in-person attendees can.

8. Is the only way to join the presentation through the QR Code?

No. Attendees can also visit menti.com and enter a unique code that will be shared during the presentation.
