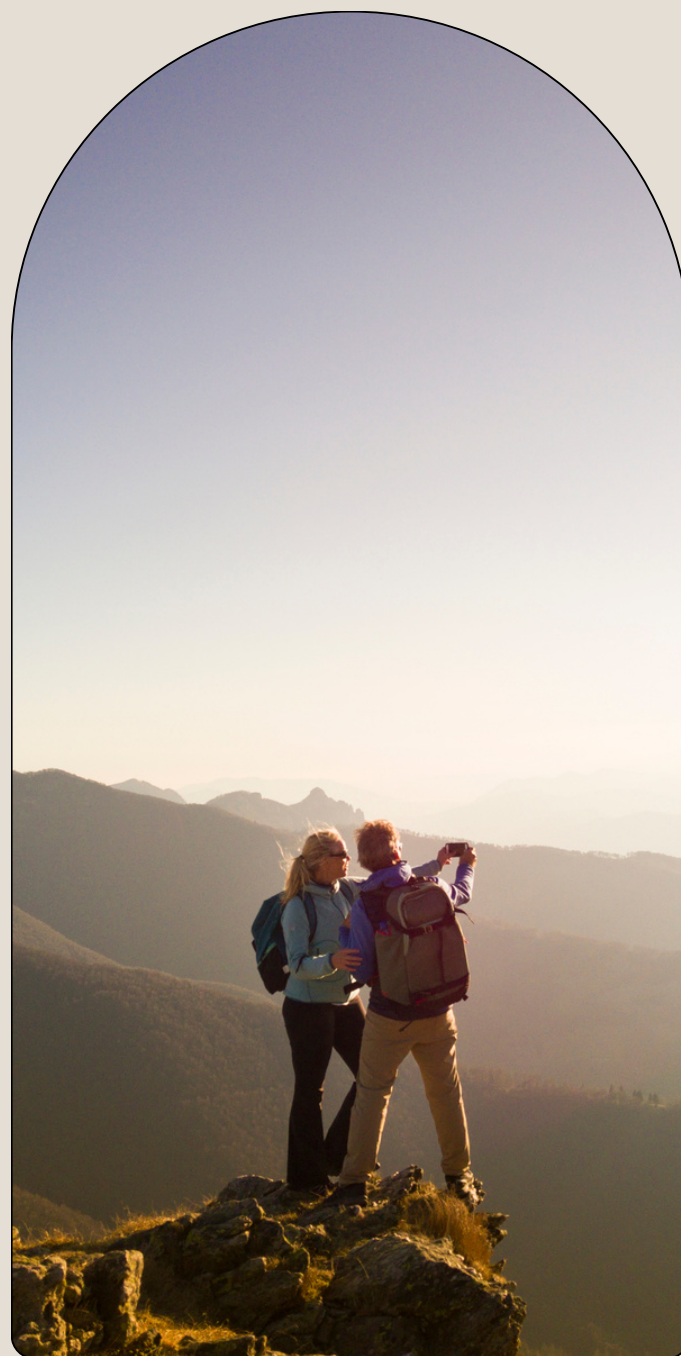
ride bikes

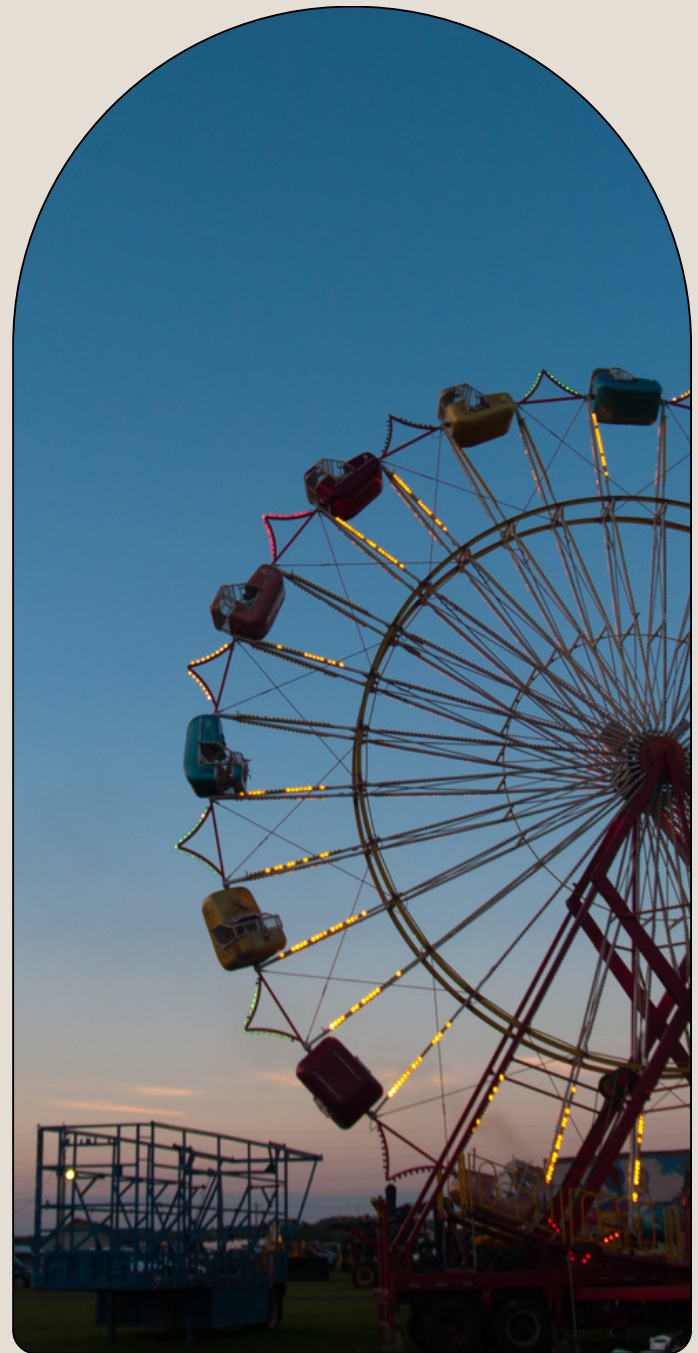
go on a hike

You don't need a fancy projector - just Netflix and a computer will work just fine. Pop some popcorn, grab your favorite candies, and watch a movie under the stars.



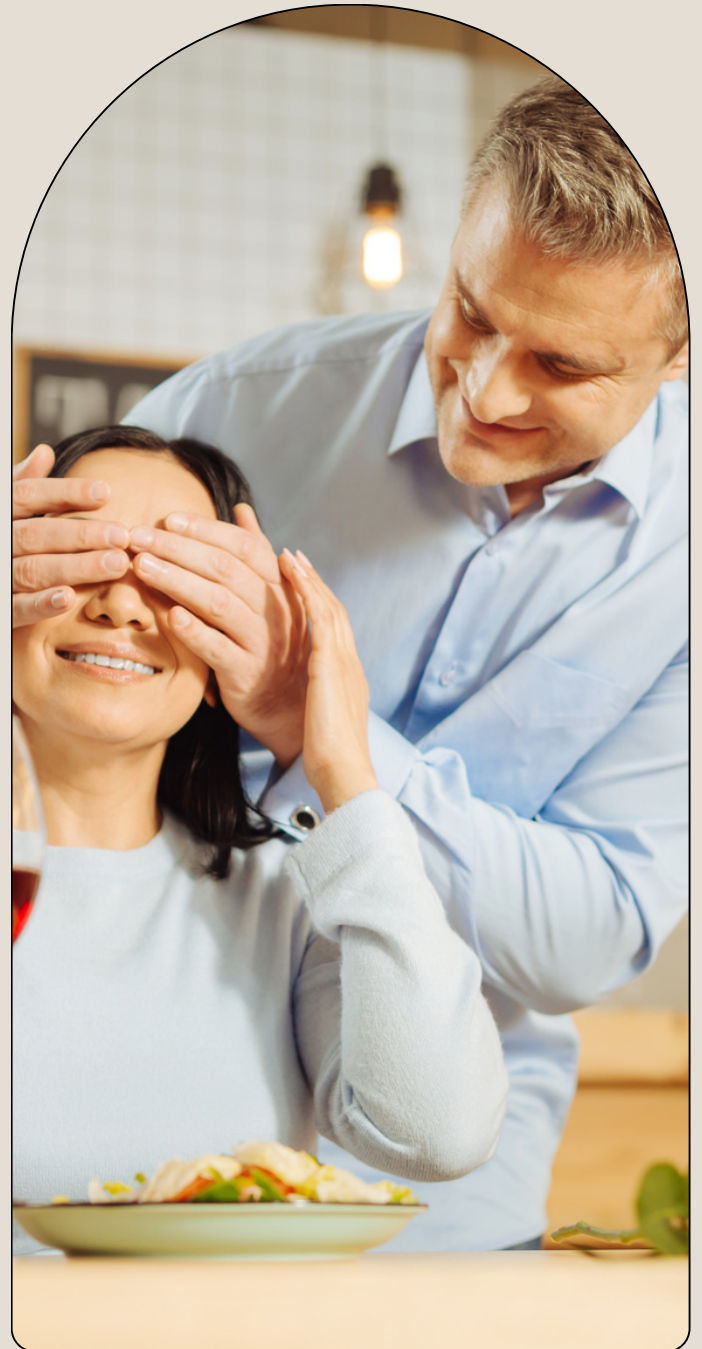
dance class

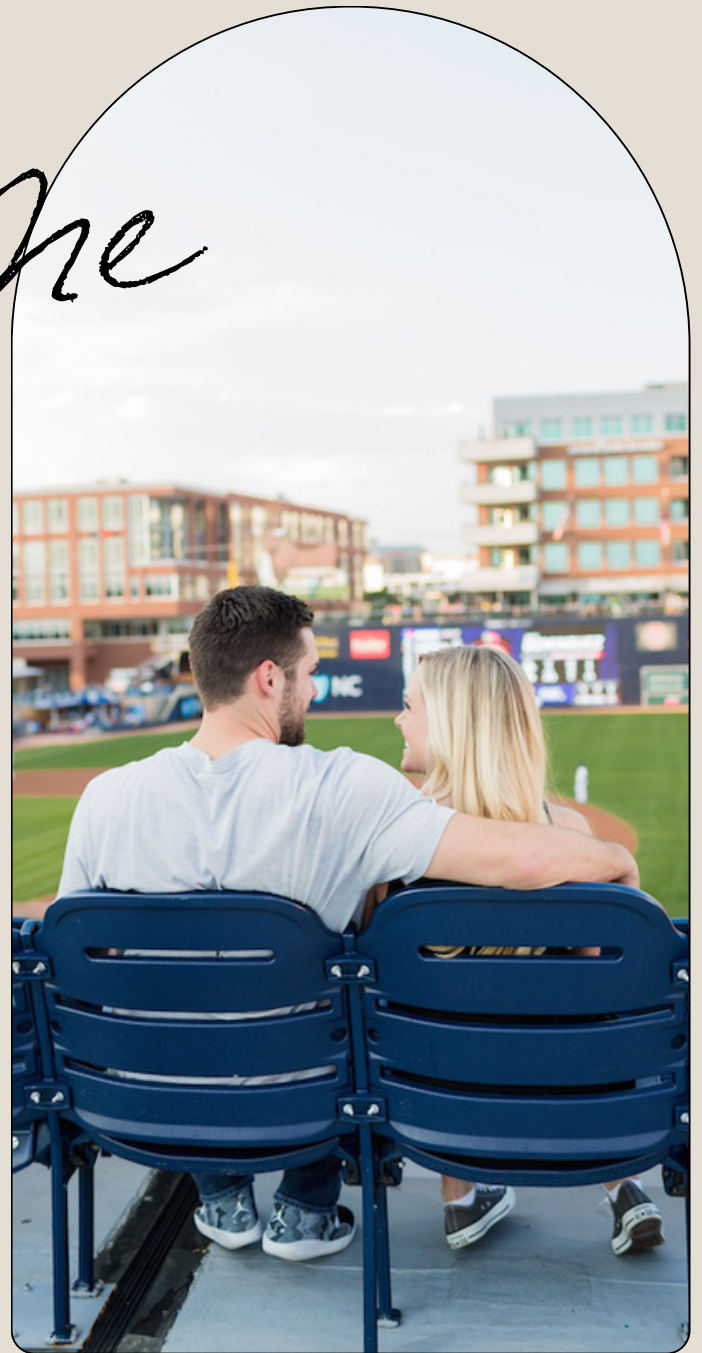
game night
