Objectives	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Oversees the sanctioning of all Taekwondo tournaments, which are competitive in nature, in the Province of Manitoba to ensure adherence with the law and Taekwondo Manitoba's Policies.• Bill S-209 and the Provincial Government through an order of council (257/2014) passed June 14, 2014, have granted Taekwondo Manitoba the sole authority to sanction taekwondo tournaments in Manitoba.
Duties	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Maintain records for all taekwondo tournaments within the province of Manitoba.2. Approve or reject applications of groups wishing to obtain sanctioning, as per approved policy.3. Report to Taekwondo Manitoba's Board on any known tournaments that not been sanctioned.4. Educate tournament organizers of their responsibilities under Bill S-209.5. Ensure sanctioning fees have been paid.
Meeting Frequency	The committee shall meet no less than 2 times per year.
