Assessments

We offer specialized assessments for children and youth aged 6-19 years old in English. The assessment will provide you with a plan to set your child or teen up for their brightest future, and help them feel better.

What are the different types of assessments?

A **Psychoeducational Assessment** describes an individual's learning profile, including their strengths and provides recommendations to support their areas of need. This type of assessment can identify learning disabilities (e.g., dyslexia), intellectual delays, etc. **If there are no concerns about your child's academic skills, this type of assessment is likely not needed. Please let us know if you have any questions.*

A **Psychological Assessment** evaluates social, emotional, and behavioral concerns that may be affecting an individual's functioning and provides recommendations to support any areas of concern. This type of assessment is able to identify ADHD, anxiety disorders, OCD, and other mental health concerns. **Please note that we do not diagnose Autism, but are able to screen and recommend further assessment in this area if necessary.*

The **Combined Assessment** covers both the Psychological and Psychoeducational Assessments.

A **Gifted Assessment** identifies giftedness and provides a list of recommendations to support your child.

What are the fees?

Assessment services are charged at a rate of \$225.00 per hour, with the exception of the intake and feedback sessions, which will be charged at a rate of \$250.00 per hour for assessments scheduled in after October 1, 2023. Below are the estimated times for the different components of each assessment; the time needed will depend on the referral question, complexity, and the child/youth. When additional time is needed this would be discussed with parent(s) and approved in advance.

Please note: Any assessments being set up after October 1 2023: payment can only be made with e-transfer.
