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COMMON AREA HEALTH AND SAFETY CLEANING

Daily Cleaning Tasks

1. Initial Inspection:

- Check for and remove any visible debris, trash, or hazards.
- 2. Trash Removal:
- Empty all trash bins and replace liners.
- Dispose of any hazardous materials properly.

3. Surfaces:

- Clean and disinfect tables, chairs, and countertops.
- Wipe down all frequently touched surfaces such as door handles, light switches, and play equipment.

4. Floors:

- Sweep and mop the floors with a disinfectant cleaner.
- Vacuum carpets and rugs.

5. Rest Areas:
