in District Court Without Prepaying Fees or Costs (Long Form). It is

FURTHER ORDERED that, if Plaintiff fails to cure all designated deficiencies within thirty (30) days from the date of this order, the action will be dismissed without further notice. The dismissal shall be without prejudice. However, Plaintiff is warned that, even if the action is dismissed without prejudice, the dismissal may act as a dismissal with prejudice if the time for filing expires. See Rodriguez v. Colorado, 521 F. App'x 670, 671-72 (10th Cir. 2013) (unpublished).
