# THE HISTORY OF

# Las Vegas

Las Vegas ("The Meadows" in Spanish) was founded as a city on May 15, 1905. The Nevada Legislature created Clark County on July 1, 1909. The new county was named after William Clark, who brought the railroad to southern Nevada. Las Vegas became the county seat. At that time, Las Vegas was only 19.18 square miles and had a population of approximately 800.

Beginning in 1931, the construction of Hoover Dam brings an influx of construction workers which starts a population boom and gives the Valley's economy, which was in the grips of the Great Depression, a needed boost. While gambling took place illegally for many years, it was officially legalized in March 1931 by the state legislature.

On a percentage basis, Las Vegas and Clark County experienced incredibly high growth rates starting in the 1930s and lasting until the Late 2000s Recession. During that period, the population of the city more than doubled in most decades. By 2000, Las Vegas was the largest city founded in the 20th century.

Despite the success, the home mortgage crisis and the Late 2000s Recession affected the economic success. While the city seems to be weathering the unprecedented recession, a slow recovery is predicted. Las Vegas has still managed to host many conventions and major events.

Las Vegas is commonly referred to as The Entertainment Capital of the World. Las Vegas is known across the globe for being a world-class destination.

### Registering your vehicle

Students and active duty personnel (including dependents) do not need to register their vehicles or acquire a new license in Nevada as long as the individual is not employed in the State of Nevada. Vehicles must be currently registered with the home state of valid insurance and driver's license.

Out-of-state drivers and vehicle registrations can be used by new residents for up to 30 days or before the prior items expire, whichever comes first. At any time during that 30 days, they may be turned in to the DMV for Nevada documents.

Nevada law requires motorists to notify DMV of a change of address within 30 days of the move. Keeping your address current is important so they can send renewal notices in the mail.

### **New Nevada Vehicle Registration**

Documents needed to register are the ORIGINALS of:

- Most recent registration
- Out of State Plates
- Nevada emissions Vehicle Inspection report (smog check) if needed
- Nevada Proof of Insurance
- Nevada Vehicle inspection certificate (VIN Check)
- Certificate of Title if ownership is changing. If not changing ownership, the owner has the option of retaining the out-of-state title.

# Clark County School District

### **Accountability Reports**

Accountability Reports furnished each spring to parents include statistics about a school's performance as well as achievements, highlights, awards, goals and technology use. Accountability Reports are available online from the Clark County School District's web site at www.ccsd.net on the "Schools" link then on School Accountability Reports.

### **Age Requirements**

Nevada law requires school attendance between ages 7 and 18. Kindergarten is part of the regular school program. A child must be five years old on or before September 30 to attend kindergarten and must be six years old on or before September 30 to enter first grade. State law requires that a child must attend a state-approved kindergarten program or take a developmental assessment test to enter first grade.

### **Bus Services**

Students who live more than 2 miles from zoned schools are eligible for bus transportation. Those who are eligible must fill out an application form requesting the service. The forms are available throughout the Clark County School District. Bus times and route schedules can be obtained through your child's school or at www.ccsd.net/transportation.

Students with zone variances will NOT be bused. Parents will be responsible for the child's transportation to and from school.

# Clark County School District

### Meals at School

All schools give students the opportunity to purchase breakfast and hot lunches.

Elementary schools - Free breakfast and \$2.00 for lunches.

Middle/High Schools - Free breakfast and \$3.25 for lunches.

For students in kindergarten through the 8th grade, applications for free or reduced-price meals can be found at the school's office or cafeteria.

### **Enrollment**

In order to enroll students:

- >> Must have proof of immunizations before classes begin
- » Parents entering their children in a District School for the first time must have identification, child's social security number, and two forms of proof of address. Proof of child's identity can be the original birth certificate or passport. Identification must be an original – no copies are accepted. The required proof of address can be a recent utility bill, rental receipt, residential lease agreement or sales contract. Telephone bills, cable bills, and driver's license are not accepted as proof of address.
- >> All students who are transferring from another school district require transcripts or report cards from the previous school.

### **Immunizations**

Nevada law requires that children in kindergarten through grade 12 are current with their immunizations before they are allowed to enter school. Parents/guardians are to bring immunization records with them to school when they register their child.

A child will not be allowed to attend school without documentation of immunizations. Exceptions are permitted for "religious objections," which requires a letter from the parent or guardian stating the religious objection, or for a medical condition, which requires a letter from a health care provider.

For the new school year, students must be up to date with all required immunizations. Students entering 7th grade also must have the recently-mandated Tdap vaccine which protects against tetanus, diphtheria and pertussis, or whooping cough.

Students new to Nevada are required to have immunizations for hepatitis A and B, and varicella (chicken pox). If a child has had chicken pox, the parent or guardian must sign a "Verification of Disease" form, which is available at each school. A second dose of MMR is required for all kindergarten and first-grade students.

### **High School Graduation Requirements**

To graduate from the CCSD, students must complete their required course work and pass the Nevada High School Proficiency Exams in reading, writing, math and science. Students who enter ninth grade must earn 22 ½ credits in the following subjects:

Math	3 credits*
Science	2 credits
U.S. History	1 credit
U.S. Government	1 credit

Physical Education	2 Credits**
World History or Geography	1 credit***
Health Education	½ credit
Computers	½ credit
Electives	7 ½ credits

- \* Mathematics course units must include at least Algebra 1 or 1H, or Applied Algebra 1A or 1B, or above.
- \*\* A maximum of one PE II waiver can be earned by participation in certain activities.
- \*\*\* World history satisfies the state Art/ Humanities requirement.


