

## PARTNER IN LAND CONSERVATION





**Project Description:** Situated between the upper and lower sections of the Kettle Moraine State Forest Loew Lake Unit, the Oconomowoc River flows through the heart of the Metz Preserve, offering extensive riparian floodplain and wetland habitat to support a variety of native fauna and flora.

**Why:** Through its acquisition, TPC is protecting the property from the increasing pressures of future development. Additionally, we are stopping excess nutrient runoff from entering into the Oconomowic River, protecting an important area of groundwater recharge, and providing natural flood protection for the region. The preserve also serves as an ideal area for outdoor recreation.
