The old metal drafting drawers that we rescued from being thrown away now hold packaging supplies so I can start my day filling orders; but first, I pop the kettle on for a nice cup of tea. It has been three years since we renovated this once run-down old building into an apartment for my daughter. Now that my daughter owns her own tiny cottage, I get to spend my days here. >

I would say I am quite a sentimental soul and love to surround myself with little bits of whimsy, texture, and things with character that tell a story.
