## GUIDED KAYAK

Tours start out with a basic lesson during which we will go over paddling etiquette, proper paddle stroke and maneuvering. Our skilled guides will then lead you on an unforgettable experience of our intricate brackish waterways in search of eagles, ospreys, herons and many other species of waterfowl while we share our knowledge of local history and lore. We will be on the lookout for river otters, muskrats, turtles and many other! We even spot whitetail and sika deer roaming the banks as well as the recently endangered Delmarva Fox Squirrel. You will be amazed at the diversity of this incredible ecosystem!

#### GUIDED KAYAK FISHING

The brackish waters of the Little Blackwater River have been locally renowned as great fishing grounds for generations, even going back thousands of years when Native Americans called the area home. Over time, the river has silted in making the bottom shallow and muddy and therefore only accessible by shallow draft vessels and kayaks. This kayak fishing adventure takes you into the nooks and covers in search of several different species of fish, primarily the invasive snakehead. Since this predatory fish entered the bay in 2002, it can now be found in every tributary and has become a very popular game fish. Using traditional spin casting techniques we will target this and a few other fun to catch fish!

## GUIDED BIKE

Your tour will start out with a basic lesson during which we will go over basic bicycle safety and then help you get fitted to your bike. Our guides will lead you on an unforgettable experience of the area searching for eagles, osprey, herons and many other species of waterfowl, deer and turkey all while filling you in on local history and culture. All tours take place on flat, paved surfaces and are catered to the needs and ability of the group.

#### BLACKWATER NATIONAL WILDLIFE REFUGE

BWNR Tours depart from our Blackwater location and within a short distance you will be on the Refuge Wildlife Drive. This scenic tour will take you through the diverse landscape of the refuge including marshes, hardwood and loblolly pine forests, as well as open farmland, all from the comfort of a flat, paved surface! This is a two hour tour with a stop at the Visitors Center
