Alderwood Loves Pets Policy

PET POLICY GUIDELINES

1. Up to 2 dogs are permitted per cabin with a \$75 fee per reservation. Pets must be approved when making a reservation.
2. Dogs must be leashed at all times outside of the cabin on Alderwood property. Dogs must not be left alone outside when leashed or tied.
3. Dogs must remain off of the furniture, including beds, and should be supervised while free inside the cabin.
4. Dogs must not be left alone inside the cabin unless crated in a guest-supplied crate. Keep in mind, most boat rental companies do not allow dogs on their boats.
5. Guests are responsible for their dog waste clean-up on Alderwood property. Please pick up waste with a doggy bag and place in the dumpster. Dog owners are responsible for all personal injuries and/or property damage related to their dog(s).
6. Alderwood Resort reserves the right to ask guests to vacate the property if their dogs are deemed aggressive, noisy, disruptive, barking, and/or are not following Alderwood's Pet Policy. Guests will be given (1) warning prior to being asked to depart from their cabin while still providing full payment.
7. Dog owners are responsible for all personal injuries and/or property damage related to their dog(s). No other pets are allowed. Damage by a pet to the property or furnishings is the pet owner's sole responsibility.

For the comfort and safety of all Alderwood guests we require dog owners to follow our Pet Policy guidelines. By paying your non-refundable reservation deposit, dog owners agree to the terms listed in Alderwood's Pet Policy.
