Student Gardener Job Duties:

- Planting of annuals, perennials, and shrubs
- Installation of seasonal décor (planters, seasonal displays, annuals, fall mums)
- Garden bed and plant maintenance including: cultivating, raking, pruning, deadheading, and weeding
- Compliance with company policies and procedures including all health & safety requirements
- Harvesting herbs for on farm products and maintaining inventory for the farm store

Working Conditions:

- Duties will primarily be outdoors and regularly exposed to varying weather conditions i.e. wet and/or humid conditions, hot and cold temperatures, snow and ice storms.
- Physical demands include but may not be limited to standing, walking, sitting, climbing, stooping, kneeling, bending, lifting, reaching, squatting, carrying, pushing, and pulling.
- Occasional irregular hours due to unexpected circumstances.
- Working hours are typically 8:00am - 2:00pm, Tuesdays + Thursdays. Occasional weekend work may be required.

- Desire to work in the horticultural/landscape industry
- 1-2 min years experience in horticultural field an asset
- Have a good knowledge of plant materials, and proficient in your abilities to care for growing plants
