When I first heard the term “human trafficking” I was 16 years old. In my youth, I never could have imagined the scale of the problem or the horrific stories of the many survivors who I now call my friends.

Over the past decade I was privileged to work alongside nonprofit organizations around the world to meet the needs of vulnerable communities. Through these experiences I began to see the urgent—and increasing—need for long-term aftercare to support rescued survivors of abuse and human trafficking. I realized that there were already many incredible national leaders in the countries where this need is extreme, and that they were the ones best equipped to provide the solution. What they needed was someone willing to support their vision and efforts. They needed an ally.

On September 5, 2019, after years of dreaming, we launched both Ally Global Foundation as a registered Canadian charity and *The Twelve Thousand* film as an awareness tool and fundraising campaign.

During the remainder of 2019, *The Twelve Thousand* film helped us connect with over 2,000 individuals through private screenings and presentations, including many of you reading this update!

It has been an incredible experience witnessing hundreds of people learn about human trafficking for the first time through my friend Sona’s true story. At Ally, we look forward to continuing our human trafficking awareness work across Canada and supporting survivors through safe homes, education and vocational training in Asia.

As we look toward our plans and goals for 2020 we’re grateful for the community of people that have become our allies. Thank you for your trust and commitment to stand against human trafficking and ensure recovery for survivors.

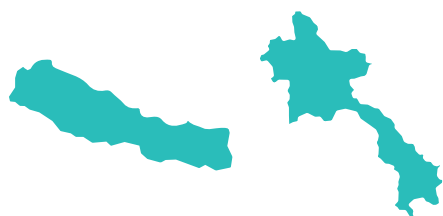

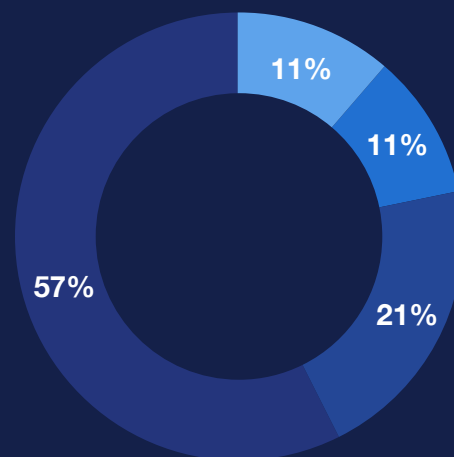
