TRAINING

Dressage: 2022 USEF Training Classic Three-Day Test – Large Arena

Phase A: 2200-3520 @ 220 mpm (10-16 mins)
Phase B: 1250 – 1560 m @ 500-520 mpm
No speed faults
4-6 jumping efforts @ 3'11" brushed
Phase C: 2400-5500 m @ 160 mpm (15-25 mins)
Phase D: as per USEF rules

NOVICE

Dressage: 2022 USEF Novice Classic Three-Day Test – Large Arena
Phase A: 2200 – 3520 m @ 220 mpm (10 – 16 mins)
Phase B: 940 m @ 470 mpm (Speed faults @ 540 mpm)
Number of Jumps: 3-6 jumping efforts @ 3'7" brushed - 6" min brush: fixed height no more than 2'9"
Phase C: 2400 – 5500 m @ 160 mpm (15-35 mins)
Phase D: as per USEF rules

BEGINNER NOVICE

Dressage: 2022- USEA Novice Test B – Small Arena
Phase A: 2200 – 3500 m @ 220 mpm (10 – 16 mins)
Phase B: 800 – 1200 m @ 400 mpm (Speed faults @ 470 mpm)
Number of Jumps: 3-6 jumping efforts @ 3' brushed – 6" min brush: fixed height no more than 2'7"
Phase C: 2400-4480 m @ 160 mpm (15 - 28 mins)
Phase D: as per USEF Rules

STARTER

Dressage: 2022 USEA Starter Test – Small Arena
Phase A: 2200 – 3500 m @ 220 mpm (10 – 16 mins)
Phase B: 800 – 1200 m @ 350 mpm
Number of jumps: 2-4 Height: 2'7" max height of brush
Phase C: 2400-4480 m @ 160 mpm (15 - 28 mins)
Phase D: 1800m @ 250 mpm, max height 2'3": 10-14 efforts

AWARDS: Trophy and ribbons to 10th.

QUALIFICATION GUIDELINES:

These guidelines were established to ensure a positive experience for all horses and participants and to help make sure they have a productive experience. We took the recommended USEA/USEF qualification requirements and “softened” them a little. While there is a component of competition to the Barnstaple Classic Three Day and Camp, the education part is a major focus of this effort. We realize that not all participants who might like to attend, will have extensive competition results. These guidelines hopefully will ensure that horses and riders are suitably ready for the week.

- Riders may request Special Permission to ride in any level

Training Three-Day Event (T3D): Open to competitors of any age, on horses four years of age or older. Both the competitor and the horse as a combination must have completed 2 horse trials at the Training level or higher,

one with no more than 20 jumping penalties at obstacles on the cross-country test. A competitor established at the Preliminary level may compete on any horse which has completed 2 HTs at the Training level or higher. Qualifying competitions must be completed within a 24-month period of the start of the competition.

Novice Classic Three-day Event (N3D): Open to competitors of any age, on horses four years of age or older. Both the competitor and horse as a combination must have completed 3 horse trials at the Novice level or higher, one with no more than 20 jumping penalties at obstacles on the cross-country test. All qualifying competitions must be completed within 24 months of the competition. A competitor established at the Training level may compete on any horse which has obtained 2 MERs at the Novice level or higher.

Beginner Novice Classic Three-day Event (BN3D): Open to competitors of any age, on horses four years of age or older. The competitor and horse as a combination must have completed 3 horse trials at the Beginner Novice level or higher, one with no more than 20 jumping penalties at obstacles on the cross-country test. All qualifying competitions must be completed within 24 months of the start of the competition. A competitor established at the Training level may compete on any horse which has completed 2 events at the Beginner Novice level or higher.

Starter Classic Three-Day Event (S3D): Open to competitors of any age on horses four years of age or older. Both the competitor and horse as a combination must have completed 2 Starter HT or above, one with less than 20 jumping penalties on the cross-country test. All qualifying competitions must be completed within 24 months of the start of the competition. *(The qualifying HT may be unrecognized competitions. Please provide proof of completion by either a copy of the results or verification from the Organizer)*

The OC reserves the right to ensure all horses and riders are suitably entered. At any time during the week, the OC may request a horse/rider combination move up or down depending on skill levels demonstrated in practice sessions.
