

[CONNECT]

Do you have a perfect past? Did you ever make a really dumb mistake when you were a kid? Think about and discuss one mistake you made growing up that you wish you could "redo"...

[ENGAGE]

What stood out to you from this weekend's message?

[GROW]

In the middle of a struggle or challenge, wow much comfort would it bring to hear these words from Jesus, "My grace is enough for you..."?

We all have our "If only..." examples of things we wish we could erase from our past. Why do you believe a lot of us can't forgive ourselves...even though Jesus DOES forgive us? (Read Romans 10:9; Psalm 103:12; Micah 7:19)

Discuss the meaning of the BIG IDEA from this weekend... What does it mean to you?

BIG IDEA - God doesn't see us through the lens of our past mistakes, but through the lens of His grace.

From the message, how can we "surrender the imperfections" of our past? What are some of the dangers of not dropping the heavy "luggage" of our past?

Sometimes we all make excuses of what disqualifies us from pursuing a healthy relationship with God. If you're comfortable sharing, describe some of the things from your past you've used for why you might not be qualified to follow after His plan for your life.

Read Proverbs 4:25-26 and discuss...

The last "prayer" we discussed in the message was, "God, help me to focus on the future You have for me." What would that look like for you to focus on God's future and reward for you instead of dwelling on your past?
