






October Virtue of the Month Awards: Obedience

November Virtue of the Month: Gratitude

Gratitude means cultivating a thankful disposition of mind and heart. In fact, the Catechism lists living in thanksgiving as one of the implications of faith in God, for, "if God is the only One, everything we are and have comes from him" (CCC 224). Jesus himself modeled the virtue of gratitude as he thanked his Father for food, for hearing his prayer, for the people the Father had given to him.

Prayer for Gratitude:*

Dear Jesus, Please give me a thankful heart, realizing that all I have comes from You.

Gratitude Looks Like:*

- Smiling at your mom after she cooks dinner
- The Blessed Mother singing the Magnificat
- Receiving legos from a friend with a smile
- Following the 10 Commandments
- Writing a thank you note
- Praying after I receive Jesus in Holy Communion

Gratitude Sounds Like:*

- Silence. Thank you, Jesus, for coming into my heart.
- Saying "thank you" to others (ex. Mom, Dad, teacher, friend, etc.).


Poem of the Month

air.




All Saints' Day | November 1 All Souls' Day | November 2

November 2nd, the Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed, dovetails with November 1st, the feast of All Saints. The saints, our models of Christian living, are one with God in heaven. All the faithful departed are those who have died with hope and trust in a loving God who calls us to greater growth and development, even beyond death. This growth and development occurs in a state of being that we have traditionally called purgatory.

These November feasts vividly remind us of the rich reality known as the communion of saints. This belief stresses the strong affirmation that the church is always one in Christ. Death does not sever any of the bonds that unite us in Christ. That is why it is a fitting practice to pray for the dead and to ask them to pray for us.
