Statement of Cooperation Between School and Parents

1. We have read the **Student Handbook** and are willing to have our children trained on this basis.
2. Since the fees do not cover the actual cost of educating our children, we recognize that our participation is needed in **prayer, service, and financial gifts** in order to properly share in their training.
3. We sincerely pledge our loyalty to the aims and ideals of the school and will bring any and all questions and criticisms directly to the Administration so that those in authority may properly consider them.
4. The Administration is hereby given full discretion in the **discipline** of our children as outlined in the current Student Handbook.
5. I understand that my children will participate in **field trips** and other **school sponsored activities**.
6. The school reserves the right to dismiss any student who does not cooperate with the educational process. If a student is dismissed for any reason, the tuition will be paid through the final month of attendance.
7. A student will be expected to maintain a **“C” average** and have a satisfactory conduct evaluation. The school Administration has the final responsibilities for the grade placement of my children. (K5-8)
8. In case of **accident or serious illness**, I request that I be contacted. If I am unable to be reached, I hereby authorize that my physician be contacted, and his/her instructions followed. If the school is unable to reach my physician, school personnel may make necessary arrangements. I agree to pay the cost and expenses so incurred.
9. I have read the **dress code policy** and will see that my children come to school dressed in accordance with that policy. I will cooperate with the school in upholding its standards of dress and conduct and will help my children understand the school's position.
