The Paris Novel, by Ruth Reichl

Stella fulfills her estranged mother's dying wish to go to Paris, where she goes on a journey of self-discovery and found family.

Madame Tussauds, by Michelle Moran

This Historical Fiction Biography gives readers an intriguing insight into Marie Tussaud's original wax works Salone de Cire, her visits to Versailles on the cusp of the French Revolution, and the development, by her descendants, of what has become the internationally renowned celebrity wax works *Madame Tussauds*.

Paris, by Edward Rutherfurd

A sweeping novel that follows six families as Paris evolves over seven decades.

The Paris Apartment, by Lucy Foley

To find her missing brother, Jess must infiltrate a secretive Parisian family and their classic mansion, in this Thriller.

Murder in the Marais, by Cara Black


The first in a 21-book police procedural series, Murder in the Marais introduces the reader to Private Investigator Aimée Leduc. Each book in the series features a different area of the city.


The Room on Rue Amelie, by Kristin Harmel


While her French husband is off fighting in WWII, American-born Ruby is left to navigate German-occupied Paris, while befriending a young Jewish girl and a British RAF pilot.











