


# How to make a GIF




with Above the Wildflowers

# Step 01




Open Photoshop  
Create custom size  
5x7 inches  
Hit create

# Step 02




Hit file at the top of the screen  
Go down to scripts  
Load files into stack

# Step 03






Select browse  
Upload the sequence of  
photos  
**MAKE SURE YOUR**  
'Attempt to automatically align'  
Button is selected before  
hitting ok

# Step 04



Go up to the window tab  
Make sure 'Timeline' is  
selected

# Step 05



This is the button you're looking for  
It is on the bottom right hand corner

Hit create frame animation at  
the bottom of the screen  
Then select 'Make frames  
from layers'  
Then select the same button  
and hit reverse frames

# Step 06



Select all [ command+a ]  
Click the 0 sec button and  
select 0.2 seconds

# Step 07



Make sure 'forever' is selected at the bottom  
Play the animation to make sure it looks good  
If there is negative space on any side of the image use the crop tool ⌘ and bring it in



Open the momento app


# Step 10
