Here are a few of the highlights of this important DSACK fundraiser:

- We had 68 teams several of them new this year that raised nearly \$134,000! That's money that goes toward funding our programs and events so we can offer them free of charge to families.
- We couldn't have done it without the more than 100 volunteers who helped Friday and Saturday mornings to make our biggest fundraiser of the year a success.

very popular Bubble Bug, Teasley's Rolling Video Games and more inflatables.

- We had tailgaters galore, which further added to the festive atmosphere.
- For the second year in a row, the event was held at the Fairgrounds in beautiful Masterson Station park. What a great place for this event so great, we've already booked it again for next year (mark your calendars for Sept. 12). I think it's safe to say Masterson Station is "home" to the Fall Family Fun Day and Walk. It gives us plenty of space to expand, which we want to continue to do.
