



# Let's review what you read this week:



Let's Look up the word- Insecurity. Insecurity is defined as "Lacking confidence or assurance; self-doubt." Sometimes you can feel insecure in your friendships, family relationships, and even insecure about yourself. Insecurity toward yourself is often described as not feeling comfortable in your own skin. But as a Christian, you have a solid, unshakeable foundation in God. Your greatest identity is found in him!

Moses had many insecurities. He didn't feet like he could be used by God. What did you learn from our story when Moses told God how he felt? Did God choose someone else to deliver the Israelites? No! God doesn't make mistakes.

It's important you learn more about who God is. Knowing your Heavenly Father more personally can be truly rewarding. He made you wonderful Just the way you are. He will use you mightily. It may look different than how he uses someone else, but his ways will glorify his Kingdom. If we all looked and acted the same we would resemble robots. BORING!

So, the more you know about God's Character, the easier it is to rely on Him as a source of security and not an unknown source of fear.
