

8/18 2 Timothy 2:15

Do your best to present yourself to God as one approved, a worker who has no need to be ashamed, rightly handling the word of truth.

8/25 2 Timothy 3:16-17

All Scripture is breathed out by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and for training in righteousness, that the man of God may be complete, equipped for every good work.

9/9 1 Thessalonians 5:11

9/16 John 15:13-14 & 17

9/23 Galatians 6:7&10

Do not be deceived: God is not mocked, for whatever one sows, that will he also reap. So then, as we have opportunity, let us do good to everyone, and especially to those who are of the household of faith.

10/14 1 Peter 1:18-19

11/10 **Psalm 105:3-4**

Glory in his holy name; let the hearts of those who seek the LORD rejoice! Seek the LORD and his strength; seek his presence continually!

11/18 Colossians 1:16-17

For by him all things were created, in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or rulers or authorities—all things were created through him and for him. And he is before all things, and in him all things hold together.

12/9 **Proverbs 15:1-3**

12/5 **Proverbs 15:4-5**

A gentle tongue is a tree of life, but perverseness in it breaks the spirit. A fool despises his father's instruction, but whoever heeds reproof is prudent.

2/3 Psalm 139:7-10

2/10 **Psalm 139:11-12**

If I say, "Surely the darkness shall cover me, and the light about me be night," even the darkness is not dark to you; the night is bright as the day, for darkness is as light with you.

3/10 Ephesians 4:21-24

3/24 **Proverbs 2:1-5**
